37 MPs of current Rajya Sabha (out of 219, i.e. 17%) had criminal cases pending against them according to self sworn affidavits filed at time of their election to Rajya Sabha

Out of these 37 current MPs of Rajya Sabha with pending criminal cases, 12 MPs (out of 219, i.e. 5%) had serious criminal cases pending against them according to self sworn affidavits filed at time of their election to Rajya Sabha

Annual asset and liability declarations collected for 183 Rajya Sabha members from Rajya Sabha secretariat

98 (out of 183, i.e. 54%) MPs in current Rajya Sabha are crorepatis

Number of women MPs very low in Rajya Sabha (9%)

NEW members Mr. LC Jain (Former member of Planning Commission), Mr. IC Dwivedi (Former DGP UP), Mr. N Gopaldaswami (Former CEC) and others ask parties to act on growing influence of crime and money in politics

Delhi, April 06, 2010: Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and National Election Watch (NEW), a nationwide campaign comprising of more than 1200 NGOs and other citizen led organizations, has been working on electoral reforms, improving democracy and governance in India.

NEW and ADR have analyzed affidavits of 219 Rajya Sabha members furnished by them at time of their election to Rajya Sabha. We have also analysed asset and liability information available for 183 members for the year 2008-2009 from the Rajya Sabha Secretariat. Executive summary is given below-

1. Analysis based on pending criminal cases

- i. A total of 37 (17 %) Rajya Sabha MPs have declared pending criminal cases against them according to their self declared affidavits submitted at time of elections. On the other hand, 162 (30%) MPs in current Lok Sabha have pending criminal cases against them.
- ii. Out of these 37 MPs with pending criminal cases, 12 (5%) MPs have serious criminal cases pending against them. These serious cases include attempt to murder, kidnapping, abducting, voluntary causing hurt by dangerous weapons etc. Amongst the MPs with pending criminal cases of heinous nature, Kamal Akhtar (SP) from UP and Ram Chandra

Singh (CPI) from West Bengal have attempt to murder cases pending against them and Azaj Ali (JD(U)) from Bihar has pending case of kidnapping and abduction.

On a **comparative note**, in **current Lok Sabha** there are pending serious criminal cases against 76 MPs (14%).

- iii. Amongst major parties, most parties have MPs with pending criminal cases such as INC has 7 out of 67, BJP has 6 out of 45 and SP has 3 out of 12 Rajya Sabha MPs with criminal cases pending against them. Details for such MPs for major parties are given below:

- iv. When analysed state wise, maximum Rajya Sabha MPs with pending criminal cases are from UP with 8 out of 31 MPs having criminal cases pending against them. This is followed by Maharashtra with 6 MPs out of 18 MPs having pending criminal cases.

2. Analysis based on Assets and Liabilities

This analysis is based on annual asset & liability declaration furnished by Rajya Sabha members under sub-rule (1) of the Members of Rajya Sabha (Declaration of assets and Liabilities) Rules, to the Rajya Sabha Secretariat. These declarations were made by MPs as on March 31, 2009.

- A total of 98 Rajya Sabha MPs out of analyzed 183 (54%) Rajya Sabha MPs are crorepatis. On the other hand, in the current Lok Sabha 315 out of 543 MPs (58%) are crorepatis.
- Amongst major parties, 65% of INC Rajya Sabha MPs are crorepatis, whereas 53% of BJP Rajya Sabha MPs are crorepatis.
- When analyzed state wise, maximum number of crorepati Rajya Sabha MPs are from Uttar Pradesh (17 out of 26, i.e. 65%) followed by Maharashtra (13 out of 15, i.e. 87%).

- iv. Highest assets have been declared by Rahul Bajaj, IND (Rs 300 crores) from Maharashtra followed by Dr. M.A.M. Ramaswamy, JD(S) (Rs 278 crores) from Karnataka. These are followed by Subbarami Reddy of INC with 272 crores. Details of 10 crorepati Rajya Sabha MPs with highest declared assets are as given below-

Commenting on the analysis **Mr. LC Jain, former member Planning Commission and member of national election watch** said, “Rajya Sabha is called the “upper house” and its members are chosen through a special process. The entry of people with criminal cases is an assault on the dignity of the upper house. It is also shocking that women members are only 9%. All the stock argument used against

women for candidates for Lok Sabha that they cannot win elections do not apply to Rajya Sabha. It gives credence to the belief that our political parties have deep seated aversion to women.”

Mr. IC Dwivedi, former DGP UP and member of National Election Watch said, “The analysis reveals that the chosen representatives of political parties in Rajya Sabha no longer symbolize the detached and distilled wisdom of the country. Not only the growing influence of money power is clearly visible but it is shocking that some persons with noticeable criminal antecedents have been chosen despite the fact that the ‘compulsions of competitive electoral battles’ to match muscle and money power are not there and securing a seat depends on the strength in the electoral college.”

Mr. N Gopalaswami, former chief Election Commissioner of India, said “It is unfortunate that our Parliamentarians are not bothered about bringing electoral reforms to keep out people with criminal records from becoming Law Makers. Criminal Law Makers continuing in the Parliament is a blot on our Democracy.”

Pending criminal cases against Rajya Sabha MPs

A total of 37 Rajya Sabha MPs have declared pending criminal cases against them according to their self declared affidavits submitted at time of elections. Out of these 37 MPs, 12 MPs have serious pending criminal cases against them. These serious cases include attempt to murder, kidnapping, voluntary causing hurt by dangerous weapons etc.
