Kolkata, April 23, 2009: National Election Watch - West Bengal chapter is part of National Election Watch (NEW), a nationwide campaign comprising of more than 1200 NGOs and other citizen led organizations working on electoral reforms, improving democracy and governance in India. NEW is monitoring the Lok Sabha 2009 at national level. NEW WB chapter has come up with the analysis for the first phase of LS 2009 election in the state. NEW West Bengal looked at the affidavits of 134 candidates belonging to various political parties for 14 constituencies where polling will be conducted on 30th April.

After analysing the information provided by the candidates on the affidavits following key observations were made:

Highlights

- ✓ Total no. of candidates with criminal records - 24, 18 percent of total candidates which is higher than that of the national average of 17%.
- ✓ Almost all political parties have fielded candidates with criminal records ; JMM -7, BJP – 3, BSP -2, AITC -1, AIFB -1 , INC -1.
- ✓ Most constituencies have candidates with criminal background contesting elections. Jalpaiguri (3), Raiganj (3), Coochbehar (3) registered maximum number of candidates with criminal charges.
- ✓ There are total 45 charges of heinous nature on the candidates which includes, murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping, extortion, etc.
- ✓ There 7 corerpatris among all candidates and 12 candidates with assets above 50 Lakhs.
- ✓ 9 candidates have no assets and 22 candidates have assets worth less than 50 thousand.
- ✓ 44% of candidates either don't have or have not furnished the PAN card details.
- ✓ Among major parties average asset value per candidate for AITC – 1.9 Crore, BJP – 78 Lakhs, INC – 60 Lakhs, CPM – 25 Lakhs.
- ✓ Only 6 female candidates (4% of all candidates) have been fielded by all political parties.
- ✓ About 55% candidates have a graduate degree or higher compared to national average of 60%.

How to get Information on Candidates

SMS

We have started a SMS campaign to enable voters to get information on candidates' background which includes criminal records, assets, liabilities and education qualifications to help them make an informed choice while voting.

A person can SMS MYNETA (Space) <PIN code> and send it to 56070 and receive a reply with the sitting MP's data and one week before the election in your constituency you will receive information of all candidates from your constituency.

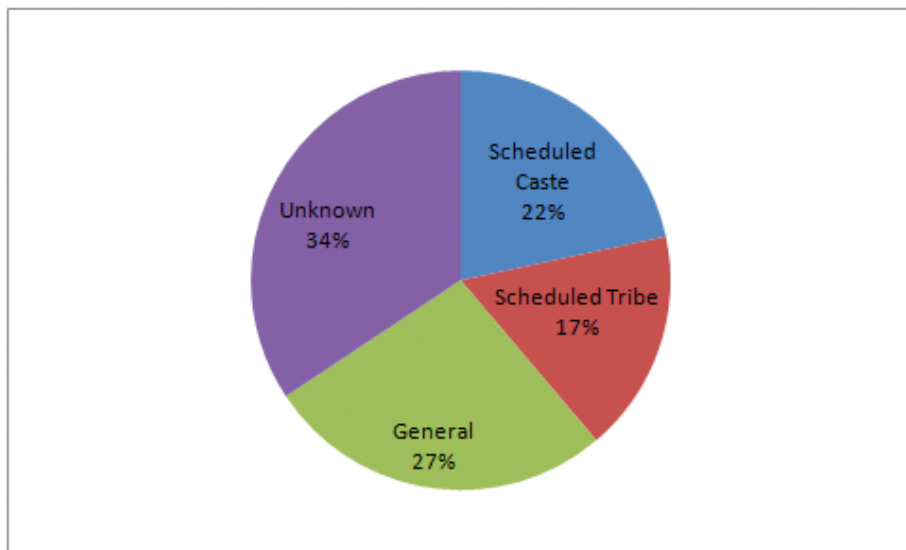


Chart: Overall Category Report

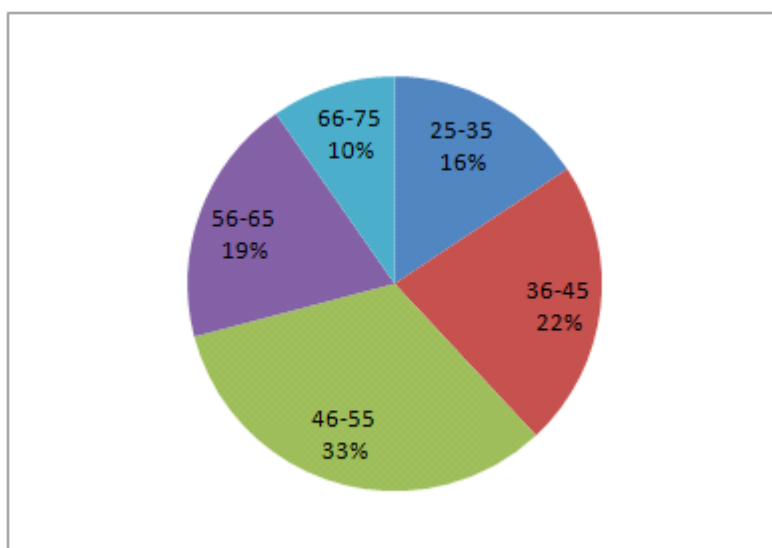


Chart: Overall Age Report

Table: Party-wise Gender Report

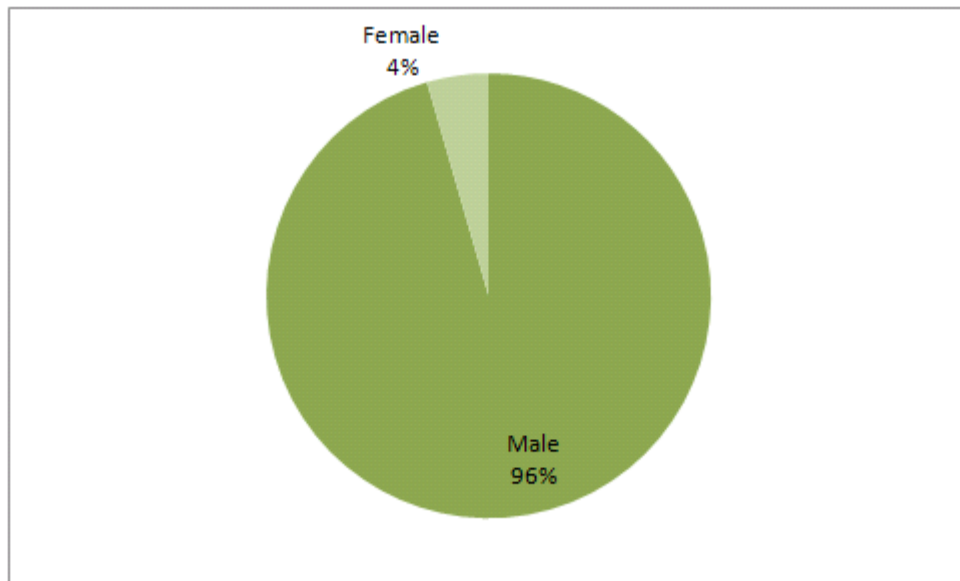


Chart: Overall Gender Report

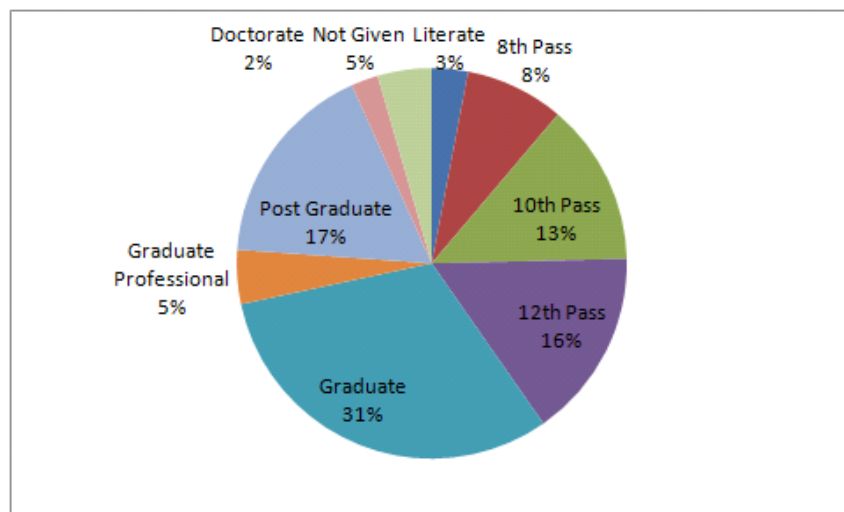


Chart: Overall Education Report

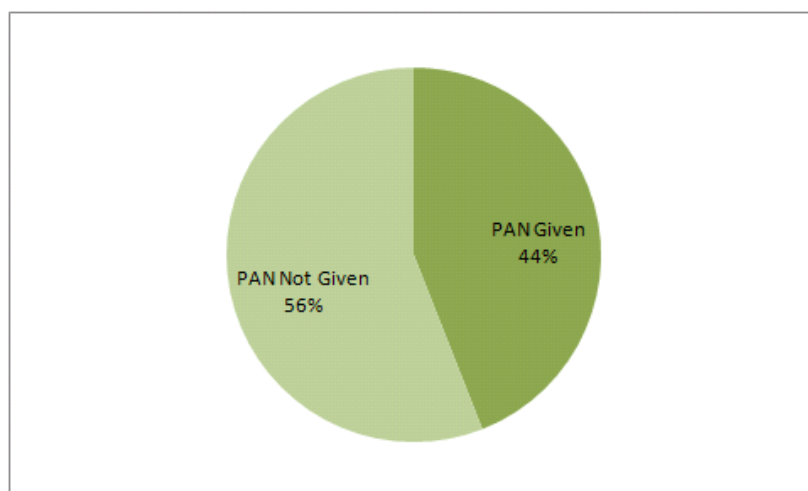


Chart: Overall PAN report
