**Comparison of Assets of Re-contesting MLA of Arunachal Pradesh from 2004 to 2009**  
 (based on self declared affidavits)

***The average increase in assets of MLAs of outgoing Arunachal Pradesh assembly is 240% or Rs 1.2 Crores***

**New Delhi:** National Election Watch (NEW) and ADR has done the analysis of the difference in assets based on the self declaration by candidates in the affidavits filed by them during 2004 and 2009 elections.

NEW has found 45 MLAs from the outgoing Arunachal Pradesh Assembly that are re-contesting in these elections and whose affidavits are available for both 2004 and 2009 elections in clear, legible manner.

It has found that the average increase in the assets of the MLAs has been Rs 1.2 Cr which comes to around 240% average. Dorjee Khandu of INC has shown maximum increase in assets of 18.7 Cr or 447%. He is followed by Chowna Mein of INC who has shown an asset increase of 14.97 Cr or 397%.

Candidate with Highest Asset Increase = Dorjee Khandu Of INC (Rs 18.7 Cr)  
 Candidate with 2<sup>nd</sup> Highest Asset Increase = Chowna Mein of INC (Rs 14.97 Cr)
