

## Press Release – October 5, 2009 – For Immediate Publication

Nagpur, India –

National Election Watch (NEW), an umbrella group of more than 1200 NGO's released information and analysis pertaining to **45** candidates of 12 constituencies of Nagpur district of Maharashtra, contesting the Vidhan Sabha elections on October 13. This analysis is based on data made available to Maharashtra and Mumbai Election Watch, local groups affiliated with National Election Watch.

Of the total 3559 candidates, of which 1820 are independents, the report at the time of going to press pertained to **45** candidates of 12 constituencies of Nagpur district.

Major political parties continue to field candidates with criminal background. Despite citizens' demand for cleaner candidates, the parties continue to ignore this aspect of tainted candidates. Former DGP Arvind Inamdar urged voters, "If you want stability, security and prosperity, do not vote for criminal candidates!"

NEW and Association for Democratic Reforms have provided detailed analysis of all candidates via websites, a national toll free telephone number and sms service. Filmmaker Rakeysh Mehra, of Rang de Basanti fame, who also helped make voter awareness films, urged the youth to "Go and vote with open eyes. Make an informed choice".

### Highlights –

- **This report is based on affidavit data for 45 (out of total 199) candidates from 12 constituencies in Nagpur district**
- Total no. of Candidates with Criminal Records = 17 (i.e. 38% of 45 candidates)
  - **Nagpur West** tops the list with 100% (3 of 3) candidates with criminal records
  - Most of the major political parties have fielded candidates with criminal records.
    - BJP (6 out of 8), INC (2 out of 7), NCP (1 out of 2), SS (2 out of 2), MNS (1 out of 3) and BSP ( 2 out of 8).
- 13 "Karodpatis" in 45 candidates (29%)
  - 3 of 4 candidates from **Hingna**
  - 5 of 7 from **INC** (71%), 5 of 8 from **BJP** (63%)
- 47% of candidates (21 of 45) have not furnished PAN card details.
- 20 (of 45) candidates are graduates and above.
- Total assets value for 45 candidates = Rs. 52 crores
  - Highest assets are of Chaturvedi Satish Jaulal from Nagpur east constituency, more than 21 crores
- Average assets value for 45 candidates = Rs. 1.2 crores
  - Average assets value for 3 candidates from **Nagpur East** = Rs7.4 crores
  - Average assets value for 7 candidates from **INC** = Rs.4.3 crores
  - Average asset value for 8 candidates from **BJP**= Rs 1.2 crores
  - Average asset value for 2 candidates from **NCP**= Rs 1.4 crores

- Average asset value for 2 candidates from **SS**= Rs 82 lakhs
- Average asset value for 8 candidates from **MNS**= Rs 12 lakhs
