Analysis of affidavits of Punjab Lok Sabha contestants 2009

Chandigarh, May 03, 2009: Punjab Election Watch (PEW) is a part of National Election Watch (NEW), a nationwide campaign comprising of more than 1200 NGOs and other citizen led organizations including Association for Democratic Reforms. It has been working on electoral reforms, improving democracy and governance in India. It has so far analysed more than 6700 affidavits of candidates contesting in Lok Sabha Elections 2009 including those of **218** candidates from Punjab.

Highlights of Punjab contestants in Lok Sabha 2009 elections –

1. There are 19 candidates who have a record of criminal cases against them out of total 218 which is about 8.7 % . This is well below the national average of about 15.5% based on about 6700 affidavits analysed so far all over India.
2. There are 49 crorepatris which is about 22.5% of 218.
3. Top 3 political parties in terms of richest candidates are BJP (17.2 crores), INC (9.6 crores) , SAD (9.1 crores) [average assets per candidate given in the brackets]. All 26 candidates belonging to these parties are crorepatris without exception.
4. There are 13 female candidates out of 218 which is about 6 %
5. Among parties, BJP, LJP and SAD(M) have one candidate each with serious criminal cases against them.
6. Bathinda, Patiala and Amritsar are the red alert constituencies where 3 candidates each with criminal charges are in the fray.
7. About 58% of the total candidates have not furnished their PAN numbers.
8. Top 3 parties in terms of average liabilities of their candidates are BSP (20.2 lacs), SAD (17.9 lacs), INC (15.6 lacs)
