

Assets Comparison of Re-Contesting Candidates in the Chhattisgarh 2013 Assembly Elections

Summary of asset comparison of re-contesting candidates

Chhattisgarh Election Watch (CEW) and Association of Democratic reforms (ADR) have analysed self-sworn affidavits of **983 candidates out of 986** contesting in 90 constituencies in the Chhattisgarh State Assembly Elections 2013.

156 re-contesting (candidates who fought elections in 2008 and now in 2013 are again in the fray) candidates have been analyzed for the Chhattisgarh Assembly Elections 2013

- The average assets of these 156 candidates fielded by various parties in 2008 was **Rs. 69,79,804 (69.79 Lakhs)**
- The average assets of these re-contesting candidates now in 2013 is **Rs. 2,05,93,440 (2.05 crore)**
- The average asset growth for these re-contesting candidates is **Rs. 1,36,13,636 (1.36 Crores)**
- Average percentage growth in assets for these re-contesting candidates is **195%**
- Out of the 156 re-contesting candidates, 68 are sitting MLAs in the outgoing assembly and their assets have grown by **168%** since 2008. 36 sitting BJP MLAs have shown average asset increase of **Rs.1.41 crores** and 31 INC MLAs have shown average asset increase of **Rs.2.54 Crores**.

Summary of asset comparison of re-contesting MLAs

- **MLAs Contesting Again:** Chhattisgarh Election Watch (CEW) and Association for Democratic Reforms analyzed 68 outgoing MLAs who are contesting again in the 2013 Chhattisgarh Assembly Elections.
- **Average Assets in 2008 Elections:** The average asset of these 68 re-contesting MLAs fielded by various parties in 2008 was **Rs 1.13 Crores**.
- **Average Assets in 2013 Elections:** The average asset of these 68 re-contesting MLAs now in 2013 is **Rs 3.04 Crores**.
- **Average Asset growth in 5 years (2008-2013):** The average asset growth for these 68 re-contesting MLAs, between the Chhattisgarh Assembly Elections of 2008 and 2013, is **Rs 1.90 Crores**.
- **Percentage growth in 5 years (2008-2013):** Average percentage growth in assets for these 68 re-contesting MLAs is **168%**.
- **Highest growth In Assets in 5 years (2008-2013):** **Rajkamal Singhaniya** of INC from Kasdol constituency has declared maximum increase in assets with an increase of **Rs 23.14 Crore** i.e from Rs 10.17 Crores in 2008 to Rs. 33.31 Crores in 2013. Assets of **Amitesh Shukla** (of INC from Rajim constituency) have increased by **Rs 17.11 Crores**, from Rs 4.15 Crores in 2008 to Rs 21.26 Crores in

2013. Assets of **Gurumukh Singh Hora** (of INC from Dhamtari) have risen by **Rs 5.66 Crores**, from Rs 6.02 Crore in 2008 to Rs 11.68 Crores in 2013.

Analysis of Re-contesting Winners

Average asset increase for Re-contesting winners in Chhattisgarh 2013 Assembly Elections- Party-wise (i.e MLAs in 2008 elections and re-contesting in 2013):

Out of the 156 re-contesting candidates, 68 are sitting MLAs in the outgoing assembly and their assets have grown by **168%** since 2008. 36 sitting **BJP MLAs** have shown average asset increase of **Rs.1.41 crores** and 31 **INC MLAs** have shown average asset increase of **Rs.2.54 Crores**.

Asset comparison of re-contesting Winners (Asset - wise)

Rajkamal Singhaniya of INC from Kasdol Constituency has shown the maximum asset increase worth **23.14 Crores** followed by **Amitesh Shukla** of INC from Rajim Constituency with an asset increase worth **17.11 Crores** and **Gurumukh Singh Hora** of INC from Dhamtari constituency with an asset increase worth **5.66 Crores**.
