Integrated Summary of Criminal, Financial and Other details of newly elected MLAs in -Tripura, Nagaland and Meghalaya Assembly Elections2013

 National Election Watch (NEW) and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analyzed the affidavits of all the 60 newly elected MLAs in the Tripura, all 59 newly elected MLAs in Nagaland and all 60 newly elected MLAs in Meghalaya 2013 Assembly Elections.

Financial

• Crorepati MLAs

Crorepatis MLAs that have got elected in the Meghalaya and Nagaland Assembly Elections of 2013 constitutes to 60% in each of the state assemblies. Especially in Meghalaya, the numbers of crorepatis have gone from 15 in 2008 Assembly Elections to 36 in 2013 elections.

The average asset declared by a newly elected Meghalaya MLA has risen from Rs. 1.12 crores in 2008 to Rs. 7.77 crores in 2013, an increase of whopping 530% in 5 years.
