

Summary and Highlights

Punjab Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 117 newly elected MLAs in the Punjab 2017 Assembly Elections.

Criminal background

- MLAs with criminal cases:** Out of the 117 MLAs analysed, **16(14%)** MLAs have declared criminal cases against themselves. Out of 117 MLAs analysed during **Punjab Assembly elections in 2012**, **19 (16%)** MLAs had **declared criminal cases** against themselves.
- MLAs with serious criminal cases:** **11(9%)** MLAs have declared serious criminal cases including cases related to **murder, attempt to murder, dacoity, robbery** etc. Out of 117 MLAs analysed during **Punjab Assembly elections in 2012**, **5 (4%)** MLAs had **declared serious criminal cases** against themselves.




Figure: Comparison of MLAs with declared criminal cases in 2012 and 2017


- MLAs with cases related to murder and attempt to murder:** **3** MLAs have declared cases related to **murder and attempt to murder**. Out of the total **3**, **2** MLAs are from **INC** and **1** is from **Lok Insaaf Party**.
 - MLAs with cases related to crimes against women:** **1** MLA has declared cases related to crimes against women. Sukhbinder Singh Sarkaria of INC from Raja Sansi constituency.
- Party wise MLAs with criminal cases:** **9 (12%)** out of 77 MLAs from **INC**, **4 (20%)** out of 20 MLAs from **AAP**, **1 (7%)** out of 15 MLAs from **SAD** and **2 (100%)** out of 2 MLAs **Lok Insaaf Party** have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.

Criteria for serious criminal cases

- Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- If an offence is non-bailable
- If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- Offence related to loss to exchequer
- Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- Crimes against women.

- Party wise MLAs with serious criminal cases:** 7 (9%) out of 77 MLAs from INC, 1 (5%) out of 20 MLAs from AAP, 1 (7%) out of 15 MLAs from SAD and 2 (100%) out of 2 MLAs Lok Insaaf Party have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.




Figure: Comparison of crorepati MLAs in 2012 & 2017

- Party wise crorepati MLAs:** 67 (87%) out of 77 MLAs from INC, 15 (100%) out of 15 MLAs from SAD, 8 (40%) out of 20 MLAs from AAP, 3 (100%) out of 3 MLAs from BJP and 2 (100%) out of 2 MLAs from Lok Insaaf Party have declared assets valued more than **Rs 1 crore**.
- Average assets:** The average of assets per MLA who won in the Punjab 2017 assembly elections is **Rs. 11.78 crores** whereas the average asset for each candidate who contested in the 2017 assembly elections was **Rs. 3.49 crores**. In 2012, the average assets per MLA analyzed was **Rs. 10.10 crores**.




Figure: Comparative analysis of average assets of MLAs and contesting candidates in 2012 & 2017

- **Party wise average assets:** Among major parties, the average assets per MLA for **77 INC** MLAs analysed is **Rs 12.43 crores**, **20 AAP** MLAs have average assets of **Rs 8.33 crores**, **15 SAD** MLAs have average assets worth **Rs. 14.54 crores**, **3 BJP** MLAs have average assets worth **Rs. 5.20 crores** and **2 Lok Insaaf Party** MLAs have average assets of **Rs. 10.14 crores**

Other background details

- **Education Details of MLAs:** 45 (38%) MLAs have declared their education qualification to be between 5th pass and 12th pass while 70 (60%) MLAs have declared having an educational qualification of graduate or above.
- **Age details of MLAs:** 51 (44%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 25 and 50 years while 65 (56%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 51 and 80 years. 1 MLA is above 80 years of age.
- **Gender details of MLAs:** Out of 117 MLAs, 6 (5%) MLAs are women. In 2012, out of 117 MLAs, 14 (12%) MLAs were women.

Comparative analysis of assets of re-elected MLAs

- **Number of re-elected MLAs:** Number of re-elected MLAs analysed in the assembly elections of 2017 is 44
- **Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2012:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2012 was Rs. 11.18 crores
- **Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2017:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2017 is Rs 16.21 crores
- **Average growth in assets of re-elected MLAs from 2012 to 2017:** The growth in average assets of re-elected MLAs is Rs 5.02 crores i.e. by 45%.


