




## **Vote Share and Representativeness of Winners**

#### **Representation of Political Parties**

In the Punjab Assembly 2017, 52 political parties and independents were in the fray. These included, 7 national political parties, 6 state political parties and 39 registered unrecognized parties. In comparison, during the 2012 Punjab State Assembly elections, 37 political parties were in the fray. These included, 6 national political parties, 4 state political parties and 27 registered unrecognized parties. This reflects an increase of 40% in the number of political parties that contested in 2017 from 2012.





#### **Seat Distribution among Parties**

- The national political parties have secured 80 out of 117 seats, with Indian National Congress winning 77 seats and Bhartiya Janata Party winning 3 seats.
- The state political parties i.e. Shiromani Akali Dal won in total 15 seats and Aam Aadmi Party won 20 seats.
- Among the 39 registered unrecognized political parties, Lok Insaaf Party won 2 seats in total.




Figure: Seat distribution in Punjab Assembly Elections, 2017





#### **Vote Share of Winner**

The percentage of vote share was calculated by dividing the votes polled for the winner by the total number of valid votes polled. The value of represents of votes won by the winning candidates among the total number of valid votes polled.

Votes Share = (<u>Total Votes Polled for Winner</u>) (Total No. of Valid Votes Polled)

The winners of the Punjab State Assembly elections, 2017 won by an average of 43 % of total votes polled. In the 2012 elections winners won by an average of 46% of total votes polled.




Figure: Comparative Analysis – Vote Share of Winners




Figure: No. of Winners- Vote Share

<u>Party Wise Winners with Less than 50% of Vote Share</u> Out of 77 winners of INC, 59(76%) won with less than 50 % of total votes polled in their constituencies. 19(95%) out 20 winners from AAP; 13(87%) out of 15 winners from SAD; 3(100%) out of 3 winners from BJP and none out of 2 winners from Lok Insaaf Party have won with less than 50% of total votes polled in their constituency.




Figure: Party Wise Winners with Less than 50% of Vote Share





## Representativeness of Winners

The percentage of representation is calculated by dividing the votes polled for the winner by the electorate i.e. the total number of registered voters. This value represents the percentage of votes won by the winning candidate among the total number of registered voters in the constituency.

Representativeness= (Total Votes polled for Winner)
(Total No. of Registered Voters)

All the winners of the Punjab State Assembly Elections, 2017 won with an average of 33% of the total registered voters. This implies that the winners represents on an average, 33% of the total electorate. In the Punjab State Assembly Elections, 2012 won by an average of 36% of the total registered votes.




Figure – Comparative Analysis- Representativeness of Winners




Figure: No. of Winners - Representativeness




Figure: Party wise Winners with less than 30% of Representativeness




Figure: Winners and Margin of Victory

<u>Party Wise Margin of Victory less than 10%</u>: Out of 77 winners of **INC, 30(39%)** have won with less than 10% margin of victory. **11(55%)** out 20 winners from **AAP**; **10(67%)** out of 15 winners from **SAD**; **2(67%)** out of 3 winners from **BJP** and **none** out of 2 winners from **Lok Insaaf Party** have won with less than 10% margin of victory.




Figure: Party Wise Margin of Victory Less than 10%



### Comparative Analysis- Winners with criminal cases and their Vote Share and Representativeness

<u>Winners with Criminal Cases and their Vote Share</u>: The total votes for winners with criminal cases, serious criminal case and clean records were calculated separately. The vote share of the winners with criminal cases was calculated by dividing the total votes polled for winners with criminal cases with the total votes for those constituencies where the said winners contested from. Similarly, the vote share of winners with serious criminal cases and winners with a clean record were calculated.




**Figure: Vote Share and Criminality** 





<u>Winners with Criminal Cases and their Representativeness</u>: The representativeness of winners with criminal cases was calculated by dividing the total votes for winners with criminal cases with the total electorate in those constituency where the said winners contested from. Similarly, the representativeness of winners with serious criminal cases and winners with a clean record were calculated.
