Uttarakhand Assembly - 2007

Uttarakhand Assembly Elections was held in 2007 and subsequent bye-elections in 2007 and 2009. This report includes the analysis of criminalization of politics, use of money power, gender disparities etc in these elections. Information provided by the Election Commission of India and details from the affidavits filed by the candidates have been used for the analysis.

Executive summary of MLAs

Summary of MLAs

- Affidavits of 70 MLAs were analyzed by Uttarakhand Election Watch (UKEW).
- Out of 70 MLAs analyzed, 17 (24%) have pending criminal cases against them and 7 (10%) have pending serious criminal cases against them.
- Out of the total 17 MLAs with pending criminal cases, 8 are from BJP, 3 from INC and BSP each, 2 are Independents and 1 is from UKKD.
- MLAs of BJP have 8 serious IPC counts pending against them, while MLAs from BSP and INC have 3 and 4 serious IPC counts respectively pending against them.
- Out of 70 MLAs analyzed, 11 (16%) are crorepatis. 3 out of 8 MLAs of BSP are crorepatis while 5 out of 20 MLAs of INC are crorepatis.
- 26 (37%) out of 70 MLAs analyzed have not declared their PAN details.
- There only 4 (6%) women MLAs as compared to 66 (94%) men MLAs out of the total 70 MLAs analyzed.

Analysis based on pending criminal cases

Analysis based on the pending criminal cases –MLAs

UKEW has analyzed affidavits of all 70 MLAs. 17 (24%) MLAs out of these 70 MLAs from Uttarakhand Assembly have pending criminal cases against them. Of these, 7 (10%) MLAs have pending serious criminal cases against them.

Party- wise break up of MLAs with pending criminal cases

Out of the total 17 MLAs with pending criminal cases, 8 are from BJP, 3 from INC and BSP, 2 are Independents and 1 is from UKKD. The part-wise break-up of MLAs is given below:

Serious crimes distribution for major parties-MLAs

There are several cases of violent crimes like murder, attempt to murder, bribery, voluntarily causing grievous hurt, etc. pending against MLAs in Uttarakhand 2007 Assembly. The table below gives a summary of all serious violent offences related to murder, bribery and voluntarily causing grievous hurt. As can be seen from the table, MLAs of BJP have 8 serious IPC counts pending against them, while MLAs from BSP and INC have 3 and 4 serious IPC counts respectively pending against them.
