Executive Summary

This report, prepared by Association for Democratic Reforms and National Election Watch, focuses on the income and expenditure of National and Regional Political Parties belonging to North-East Indian states. The six national parties include Indian National Congress (INC), Bhartiya Janata Party (BJP), Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP), Nationalist Congress Party (NCP), Communist Party of India (CPI) and Communist Party of India (Marxist) (CPM).

The 15 regional parties considered for this report include Asom Gana Parishad (AGP), All India Trinamool Congress (AITC), All India United Democratic Front (AIUDF), Bodoland People's Front (BPF), Hill State People's Democratic Party (HSPDP), Manipur People's Party (MPP), Manipur State Congress Party (MSCP), Mizo National Front (MNF-ZNP), Mizoram People's Conference (MPC), Naga People's Front (NPF), National People's Party (NPP), Sikkim Democratic Front (SDF), United Democratic Party (UDP), People's Democratic Alliance (PDA) and Sikkim Krantikari Morcha (SKM).

The **executive summary** below lists the key observations that were drawn from the report:


I. Total income of political parties from all over India:

- The total income of political parties from all over India is calculated from their IT returns filed every year to the Income Tax Department.
- Four regional parties (NPP, HSPDP, PDA and UDP) have not filed their IT returns between FY 2004-05 and 2011-12.
- Among national parties, INC has the highest total income of Rs. 3,388.78 crores between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14, followed by BJP with Rs. 2,302.20 crores. BSP has a total income of Rs. 651.99 crores, NCP has a declared total income of Rs. 283.62 crores, CPI has Rs. 13.519 crores and CPM has a total income of Rs. 769.07 crores during FY 2004-05 and 2013-14.
- Among regional parties, **AITC** has the **highest total income** of **Rs. 39.99 crores**, followed by **SDF** having an income of Rs. 9.02 crores between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14. The total income of **AIUDF** is Rs. 4.24 crores, **NPF** is Rs. 43.78 lakhs, **MNF-ZNP** is Rs. 67.33 lakhs, **MPC** is Rs. 39.15 lakhs, **AGP** is 1.08 crores, **BPF** is Rs. 2.44 crores, **NPP** is Rs. 76.76 lakhs, **SKM** is Rs. 18.23 lakhs, **PDA** is Rs. 3.72 lakhs, **MSCP** is Rs. 3.50 lakhs and **HSPDP** is Rs. 0.74 lakhs between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14.




II. Share of donations in total income of political parties (as per ITR):

- Among the national parties, BJP received a total of Rs. 1,992.90 crores as donations or voluntary contributions, which forms 86.56% of its income. INC declared Rs. 441.09 crores (13.02% of its income) as donations between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14.
- Amongst the 15 regional parties of the North East, Four National People's Party (NPP), Hill State
 People's Democratic Party (HSPDP), People's Democratic Alliance (PDA) and United Democratic
 Party (UDP) have not filed their IT Returns even once between FY 2004-05 and 2011-12.
- AITC received a total donation of Rs 1380.21 lakhs which is 34.51% of its total income, AGP received Rs 79.34 lakhs which constitutes **72.94%** of its income. NPF received Rs 43.72 lakhs which is **99.76%** and MNF-ZNP received Rs 63.47 lakhs which is **94.27%** of its income.

III. Top three sources of income:

- There is **no standard format** in which political parties list their sources of income.
- Most political parties list donations, voluntary contributions and members' contributions towards
 party fund as major sources of income. AITC lists Rs. 646.90 lakhs of its income (16.18% of its total
 income) from 'sale of paintings'.







IV. Top three items of expenditure:

- Political parties have varied expenses, including election expenses, publicity and advertisement.
- AIUDF spent Rs. 167.41 lakhs (41.16% of its total expenditure) on Helicopter Hiring Charge, SDF spent Rs. 123.22 lakhs (31.92% of its expenditure) on Administrative Expense, BPF spent Rs. 89.59 lakhs (46.85% of its expenditure) on Elections Charge, AGP spent Rs. 24.39 lakhs (22.44% of its income) on traveling expense between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14.
- AITC spent Rs. 879.78 lakhs (55.97% of its total expenditure) on election expenses, while NPP spent 62.47 lakhs (65.61% of its total expenditure) on Election expenditure between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14.
- V. Number of donors contributing above Rs. 20,000 to National parties from North-East Indian states (FY 2004-05 to FY 2013-14):
 - Of the National Parties, INC has the maximum number of donors from North-East Indian states contributing above Rs. 20,000. Between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14, 222 donations belonging to North-East Indian states contributed Rs. 579.27 lakhs to the INC which is 0.17% of its total income, while 14 donations contributed Rs. 54.66 lakhs to BJP which forms only 0.023% of its income.
 - Despite of CPM being in power during this entire decade in Tripura and before, we only see donations (above Rs 20,000) coming in from FY 2011-12. This forms a paltry sum of Rs 29.10 lakhs which is only
 0.037% of the total income of CPM from FY 2004-05 to 2013-14
 - Even for CPI the total amount of donations that it received from the North Eastern States during FY 2004-05 to 2013-14 forms a minuscule 0.003% (Rs 440.599) of its total income.
- VI. Number of donors contributing above Rs. 20,000 to North-East Political Parties from all over India (FY 2004-05 to FY 2013-14):
 - Amongst the regional parties of the North East, SDF tops the list with 126 donations receiving a total
 of Rs. 812.86 lakhs between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14. AIDUF follows with 112 donations receiving a
 total of Rs. 197.88 lakhs.
 - AITC has received Rs. 154.66 lakhs from 8 donations, BPF follows with 7 donations received a total of Rs. 30.50 lakhs.

Recommendations by ADR

- The Supreme Court gave a judgment on September 13, 2013 declaring that no part of a candidate's affidavit should be left blank. Similarly, no part of the Form 24A submitted by political parties providing details of donations above Rs 20,000 should be blank.
- Full details of all donors should be made available for public scrutiny under the RTI. Some countries where this is done include Bhutan, Nepal, Germany, France, Italy, Brazil, Bulgaria, the US and Japan. In none of these countries is it possible for 75% of the source of funds to be unknown, but at present it is so in India.
- Details of donors who make **donations to the Electoral Trusts should be available in the public domain** for increasing transparency in funding of political parties.
- Any party which does not submit its donation statement to the ECI on or before 31st Oct should be heavily
 penalized and its income should not be tax-exempted





Major Political Parties of North-East India: An All-India Report Income, Expenditure and Donations between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14

Political parties represent citizens of the country at various levels of the government, voice people's demands and needs in the administrative sphere, and therefore serve as the link between citizens and the government.

Political parties rely heavily on donations for fighting elections and running their daily affairs. They receive huge sums of money in the form of donations and contributions from corporate, trusts and individuals. Section 29C of the Representation of People Act, 1951 says that political parties are required to submit contribution details received in excess of Rs 20,000 from any person or a company. Named contributions seem to be very small i.e. single contributions above Rs 20,000 seem to be very few in numbers for all the parties.

In addition to this, the coupon system has been adopted by political parties for collecting funds by issuing of coupons in lieu of receipts to donors for cash contributions. Moreover, these are cash donations and it becomes all the more difficult to establish the identity of the donor. This implies that a lot of cash donations received remain unaccounted for in the books of accounts as only those amounts would be recorded for which a receipt has been issued.

Thus, it becomes all the more important to have a strict regulatory mechanism wherein political parties have to report the correct quantum and the source of donations received. Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) had obtained copies of the IT Returns and Assessment Orders of various political parties through the filing of RTI applications.

Total income of major political parties of North-East India [FY 2004-05 and 2013-14]

The parties analyzed include **all 6 National Political Parties** and the **15 regional political parties belonging to North-East India**. The following observations were made:

- Among National Parties, INC has the highest total income of Rs. 3,388.78 crores between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14, followed by BJP with Rs. 2,302.20 crores. BSP has a total income of Rs. 651.99 crores, NCP has a declared total income of Rs. 283.63 crores, CPI has Rs. 13.52 crores and CPM has a total income of Rs. 769.07 crores during FY 2004-05 and 2013-14.
- Among regional parties, AITC has the highest total income of Rs. 3,999.33 lakhs, followed by SDF having an income of Rs. 902.07 lakhs between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14. The total income of AIUDF is Rs. 424.52 lakhs, BPF is Rs. 244.04 lakhs, AGP is 108.78 lakhs, NPP is Rs. 76.76 lakhs MNF-ZNP is Rs. 67.33 lakhs, NPF is Rs. 43.78 lakhs, MPC is Rs. 39.15 lakhs, SKM is Rs. 18.23 lakhs, PDA is Rs. 3.72 lakhs, MSCP is Rs. 3.50 lakhs and HSPDP is Rs. 0.74 lakhs between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14.
- The income of National Political Parties shows an almost steady growth between FY 2004-05 and FY 2013-14. BJP's income has grown five times (Rs 569.69 crores) from Rs. 104.12 crores in FY 2004-05 to Rs. 673.81 crores in FY 2013-14. This is 547% of what it was in FY 2004-05.
- INC's income has increased 379% (Rs 473.13 crores) from Rs 124.93 in FY-2005-06 to Rs. 598.08 crores in FY 2013-14.
- Four North-East India's regional political parties, National People's Party (NPP), Hill State People's Democratic Party (HSPDP), People's Democratic Alliance (PDA) and United Democratic Party (UDP) have not filed their IT returns between FY 2004-05 and 2011.
- Asom Gana Parishad (AGP), Bodoland People's Front (BPF) and Sikkim Democratic Front (SDF) have shown a **decrease in their income** between FY 2010-11 and FY 2011-12. AGP's income has decreased from Rs. 50.24 lakhs in FY 2010-11 to Rs. 20.54 lakhs in FY 2011-12, BPF's income has decreased from Rs. 117.5 lakhs to Rs. 28.59 lakhs between FY 2010-11 and 2011-12.
- RTIs have been filed by ADR to obtain the IT returns of some of the regional parties, responses for which are awaited, as have been mentioned in the table below. As the IT returns obtained from the Sikkim Democratic Front (SDF) was **incomplete**, data could hence not be provided.

Share of donations from total income of political parties between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14

Political parties declare their income from various sources such as sale of coupons, donations, voluntary contributions etc in their IT returns. Tabulated below is the share of donations from total income of political parties between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14. Some notable observations include:

- Among the National Parties, BJP has the highest share of donations of its total income. Between 2004-05 and 2013-14, it received a total of Rs. 1992.90 crores as donations which forms 86.56% of its income, as declared in its IT returns.
- INC received only Rs. 441.09 crores as donations between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14, a mere 13.02% of its income. The party collected Rs. 2618.58 crores of its income by sale of coupons between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14, which forms 77.27% of its income.
- Income of **BSP** from voluntary contributions is Rs. 355.91 crores, which is 54.59% of its income. **BSP** is the only National Party which claims that all the voluntary contributions it receives are below Rs. 20,000.
- Amongst the major parties of the North East, AITC received 32.55% (Rs 1301.95 lakhs) of its total income from donations, AGP received 72.94% (Rs 79.34 lakhs) of its income from donations, NPF received 99.76% (Rs 43.72 lakhs) of its total income from donations and MNF-ZNP received 94.27% (Rs 63.47 lakhs) of its total income from donations.
- MSCP received 100% of its income (Rs. 3.5 lakhs) from voluntary donations, while 96.53% of MPC's income (Rs. 37.83 lakhs) came from donations between FY 2004-05 and FY 2013-14.

Top three sources of income of major political parties of North-East India between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14

Political parties have a wide network of offices, and a diverse membership throughout the region that they operate in. All political parties cite various sources of income, of which the top three for every party have been tabulated below. Notable observations include:

- There is **no standardization in declaring sources of income** by political parties, and thus there is no consistency seen in the method of declaration of funds received by political parties.
- Manipur State Congress Party categorizes all its income under the head "Received by candidates".
- Sale of coupons and voluntary contributions are two primary sources of income for political parties. The foremost source of income for AGP (Rs. 79.34 lakhs, 72.94% of their total income) is donation and subscription. For AITC also, donations forms top source of income (Rs. 1380.21 lakhs, 34.51% of its total income), while contributions are the top source of income for MPC (Rs. 37.83 lakhs, 96.63% of its total income). Members' contributions are the foremost source of income for NPF (Rs. 39.22 lakhs, 89.58% of its total income).

Top three items of expenditure of political parties of North-East Indian between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14

Political parties have varied expenses, as declared in their IT returns. The most notable points from this analysis are as follows:

- INC, BJP, NCP, CPI, AITC, NPP and BPF spent the largest part of their income on election expenses, publicity and advertisement between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14. INC spent Rs. 1605.91 crores on election expenses, BJP spent Rs. 679.11 crores on advertising and publicity, and NCP spent a total of 152.62 crores on election expenses and publicity between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14.
- Among the regional parties, **AITC** spent Rs. 879.78 lakhs and **BPF** spent Rs. 89.59 lakhs on election expenses between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14.
- **AIDUF** is the only political party which has spent about 41.16% of total expenditure (Rs. 167.41 lakhs) on **helicopter hiring charges**.

Total number and amount of donations above Rs. 20,000 to National political parties from North-East India

ECI guidelines require political parties to record personal details of donors making contributions to their political parties in amounts excess of Rs. 20,000. Such donors are known as 'named donors'. [In its donations report, Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) states that it receives no contributions or donations above Rs. 20,000 from all over India.]

- Amongst the national parties, INC has received the maximum number of donations (222) from the North Eastern states between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14, which amounts to a total of Rs. 5.79 crores. While during the same period, NCP has received only 1 donation from here.
- If we observe the trend of donations to INC, we can see that there is a gradual increase in number and the amount of donations from FY 2008-09 to FY 2010-11 this corresponds to the fact that INC was the ruling party in many of these states. Except for FY 2011-12, the amount of donations to INC have been increasing since FY 2008-09.
- Despite of CPM being in power during this entire decade in Tripura and before, we only see donations (above Rs 20,000) coming in from FY 2011-12. This forms a paltry sum of Rs 29.10 lakhs which is only 0.037% of the total income of CPM from FY 2004-05 to 2013-14

Total number and amount of donations above Rs. 20,000 to North East political parties from all over India

- A noticeable number of Regional Parties belonging to the North-East Indian states have not submitted their donations report regularly to the Election Commission of India.
- In addition there are almost half of the total number of parties analyzed which have not submitted their
 donations report to the ECI not even once between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14. This list includes some of the
 major political parties of the North East India, like Naga People's Front (NPF) and Mizoram People's Conference
 (MPC), which were either the ruling party or the main opposition party in their respective states. Other small
 once include NPP, UDP, HSPDP, PDA, and MSCP.
- SKM which was formed in 2013 has also not submitted its donations details to the ECI.
- Sikkim Democratic Fund (**SDF**) and All India United Democratic Front (**AIUDF**) got the maximum number of donations from all over India, in excess of Rs 20,000, amongst all the North East parties analyzed.
- AGP has received only 1 donation which is worth Rs 10 lakhs between FY 2004-05 to 2013-14. While MNF-ZNP received Rs. 9.92 lakhs during FY 2008-09 to FY 2011-12 from 19 donations, while AIUDF received Rs. 197.88 lakhs contributions in 8 years from 112 donations.

Top three donors to national parties from North-East India [FY 2004-05 to 2013-14]

- Hassen Lyngdoh is the foremost donor to INC, contributing Rs. 66.37 lakhs between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14. Topcem Cement, Lohia (Rs. 50 lakhs) and Cement Manufacturing Company Ltd. (Rs. 30 lakhs) are other major donors to the INC.
- Gadi Agro Forestry Pvt. Ltd. is the top donor to BJP, contributing Rs. 39.98 lakhs between FY 2004-05 and 2013-14, followed by Cement Manufacturing Co. Ltd. (Rs. 10 lakhs) and SM Corporation Ltd (Rs. 5 lakh).
- NCP has received only one donation from North East India in these 10 FYs but that one donation is the highest amongst all donations cutting across all national parties.
