Summary and Highlights

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Maharashtra Election Watch have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of 6 out of 7 winners who had contested in the **Municipal Corporation Bye Elections** being held in **Nashik, Pune, Solapur, Ulhasnagar, Ahmednagar, Jalgaon and Greater Mumbai** on **6th April, 2018** in Maharashtra. Affidavits of one winner **Gehi Mayadevi Vijaykumar** belonging to **BJP**, who has won from ward no **26** in **Jalgaon Municipal Corporation** is not analysed as it was not available at the time of making this report.

Criminal Background

- **Winners with Criminal Cases:** 1 (17%) out of 6 analyzed winners has declared criminal cases against himself.
- **Winners with Serious Criminal Cases:** 1 (17%) out of 6 analyzed winners has declared serious criminal cases against himself like **criminal intimidation, etc.**
- **Party wise Winners with declared Criminal Cases:** 1 (50%) out of 2 winners from **Indian National Congress** has declared criminal cases

Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

- **Party wise Winners with declared Serious Criminal Cases:** 1 (50%) out of 2 winners from Indian National Congress has declared serious criminal cases against himself in his affidavit.

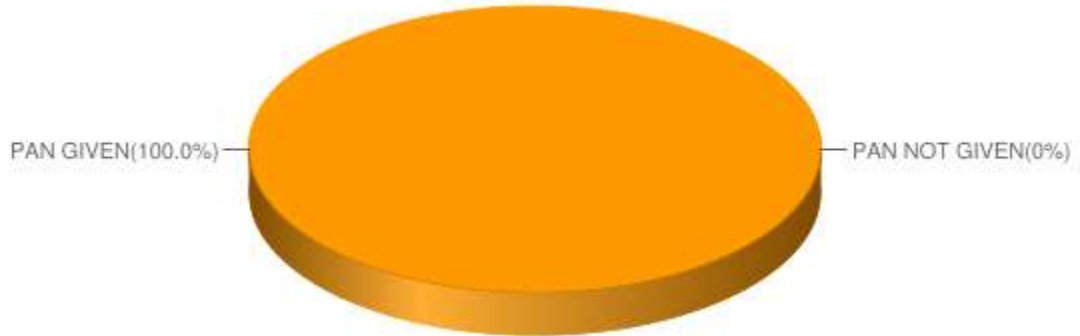

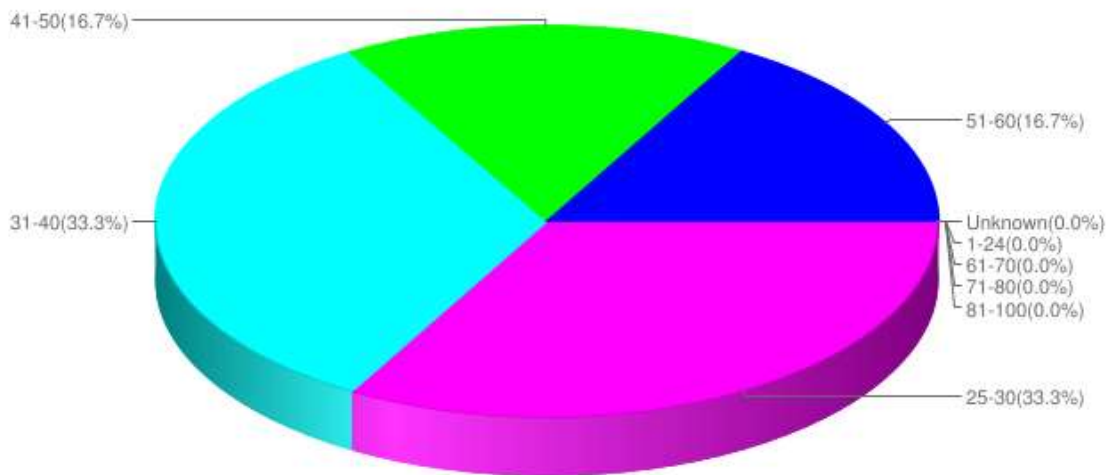

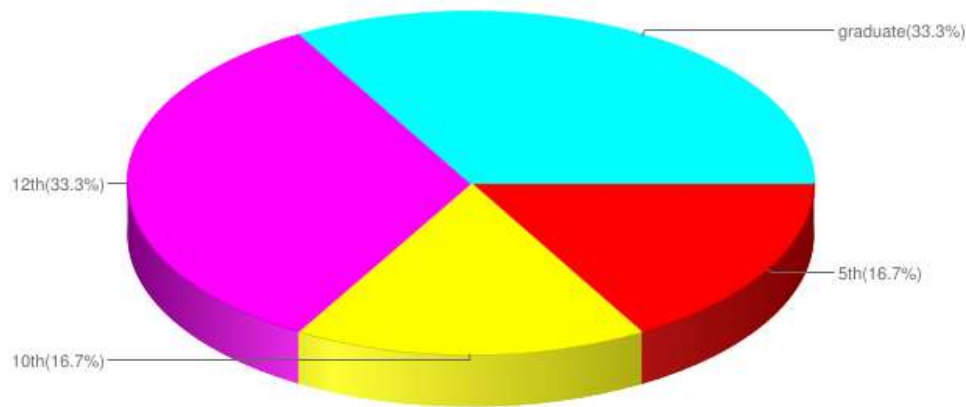

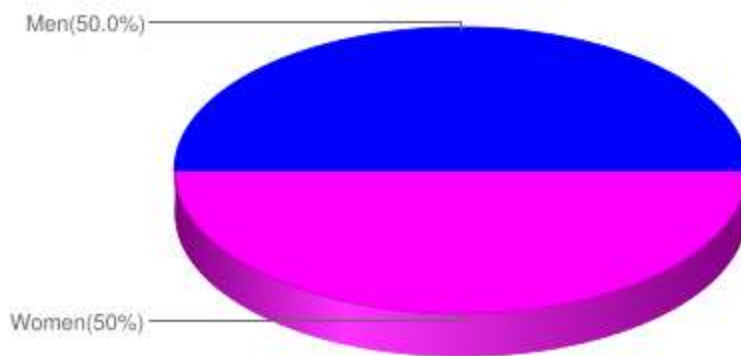
