Summary and Highlights

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Maharashtra Election Watch have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 11 winners, elected by MLAs, who had contested in the Maharashtra Legislative Council Biennial Elections, held in Maharashtra on 16th July, 2018.

Criminal Background

- Winners with declared Criminal Cases: 4 (36%) out of 11 analyzed winners have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- Winners with declared Serious Criminal Cases: 2 (18%) out of 11 analyzed winners have declared serious criminal cases against themselves like attempt to murder, etc. The details are given below:

- <u>Age Details of Winners:</u> 2 (18%) winners have declared their age to be between 41 to 50 years, 4 (36%) winners have declared their age to be between 51 to 60 years whereas 5 (46%) winners have declared their age to be between 61 to 70 years.
- <u>Education Details of Winners</u>: 2 (18%) winners have declared their educational qualification as 10th Pass, 3 (27%) winners have declared their educational qualification as 12th Pass, 2 (18%) winners have declared their educational qualification as Graduate, 2 (18%) winners have declared their educational qualification as Graduate Professional whereas 2 (18%) winners have declared their educational qualification as Doctorate in their affidavits.
- <u>Gender Details of Winners:</u> Out of total 11 analyzed winners, **10 (91%)** are men whereas **only 1 (9%)** is women.
