Criminal Background

- Winners with Criminal Cases: 2 (29%) out of 7 analyzed winners have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- Winners with Serious Criminal Cases: 2 (29%) out of 7 analyzed winners have declared serious criminal cases against themselves like criminal intimidation, etc.
- Party wise Winners with declared Criminal Cases: 1 (50%) out of 2 winners from Bharatiya janata party and 1 (100%) winner from Janata Dal Secular have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.
- Party wise Winners with declared Serious Criminal Cases: 1 (50%) out of 2 winners from Bharatiya janata party and 1 (100%) winner from Janata Dal Secular have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.

- <u>Party wise Crorepati Winners:</u> 2 (100%) winners analysed from Shivsena, 1 (50%) out of 2 winners analysed from BJP and 1 (100%) winner analysed from Janata Dal Secular, are Crorepatis.

- Average Assets: The average asset per winner for this election is Rs. 1.83 crore.
- Pan Details of Winners: All 7(100%) analyzed winners have declared their PAN details.

Other Background Details

- Age Details of Winners: 4 (57%) winner have declared their age to be between 24 to 40 years. There are 3 (43%) winners have declared their age to be between 41 to 70 years.
- Education Details of Winners: 1 (14%) winner has declared their educational qualification as 8th Pass, 2 (29%) winners have declared their educational qualification as 10th Pass and 4 (57%) winners have declared their educational qualification as Graduate in their affidavits.
- Gender Details of Winners: Out of total 7 analyzed winners, 6 (86%) are men whereas 1(14%) is woman.
