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Summary and Highlights

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) and Maharashtra Election Watch have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of **all 87** winners who had contested in the **22 wards** for the **Amravati Municipal Corporation** Elections, held on **21st February, 2017**.

Criminal Background

- **Winners with Criminal Cases:** **8 (9%)** out of **87** analyzed winners have declared criminal cases against themselves.
- **Winners with Serious Criminal Cases:** **7 (8%)** out of **87** analyzed winners have declared serious criminal cases against themselves like **attempt to murder, criminal intimidation, kidnapping, extortion, assault or criminal force to woman with intent to outrage her modesty, Cheating and forgery, etc.**
- **Party wise Winners with declared Criminal Cases:** **2 (4%)** out of **45** winners from **Bhartiya Janta Party (BJP)**, **4 (25%)** out of **16** winners from **Indian National Congress (INC)** and **1 (14%)** out of **7** winners from **Shiv Sena**, have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.

Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

- **Party wise Winners with declared Serious Criminal Cases:** 2 (4%) out of 45 winners from **Bhartiya Janta Party (BJP)**, 3 (19%) out of 16 winners from **Indian National Congress (INC)** and 1 (14%) out of 7 winners from **Shiv Sena** have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.

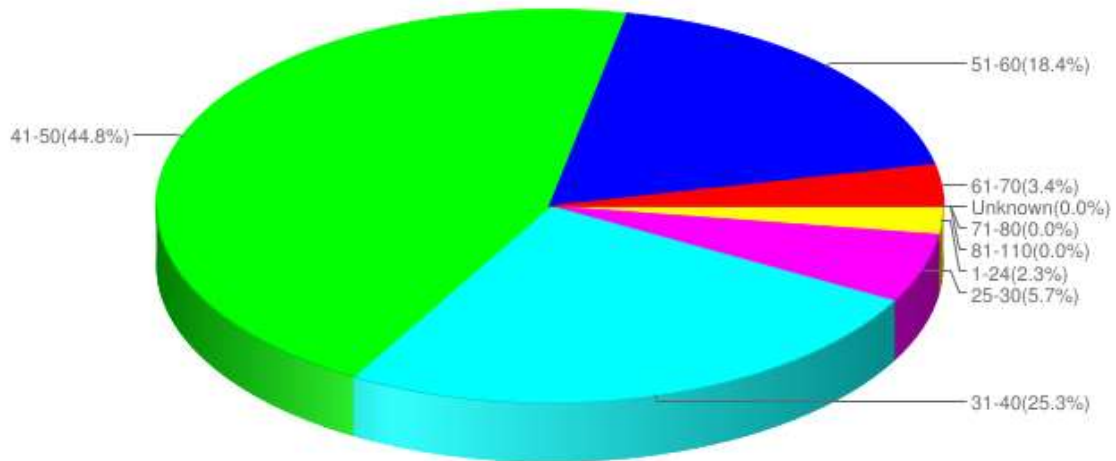

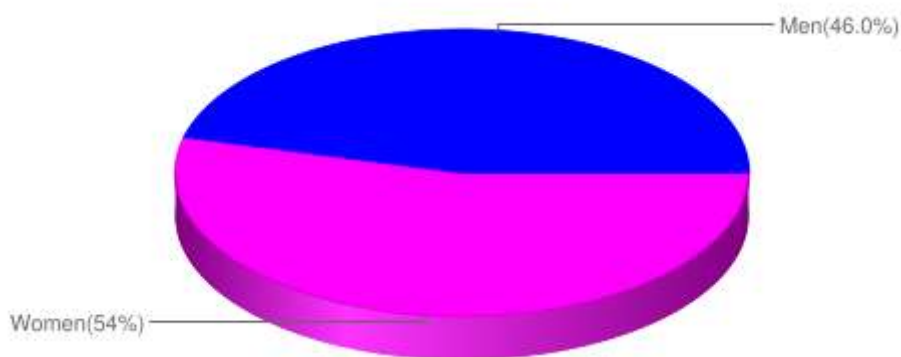
