## Analysis of Donations declared by Regional Political Parties – FY 2016-17


This report, prepared by **Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR)** focuses on donations declared by Regional Political Parties, during the Financial Year 2016-17, as submitted by the parties to the Election Commission of India (ECI).

### Executive Summary

The **executive summary** below lists the key observations drawn from the report:


#### I. Donations to Regional Parties as declared to the ECI (FY 2016-17)

- a. Under **Section 29C(1) of the Representation of People’s Act, 1951**, political parties are required to prepare a report providing details of contributions **in excess of twenty thousand rupees** from any person in a particular financial year to avail 100% tax exemption. However, in FY 2016-17, we see that **7 Regional Parties** (SAD, MGP, DMK, AINRC, AGP, NPF and DMDK) have also provided details of donations received **below Rs 20,000** in their contributions report.
- b. The total amount of donations declared by Regional Parties, including both above and below Rs 20,000, was **Rs 91.37 cr**, from **6339 donations**.
- c. With regard to the total amount of donations, **Shiv Sena** leads with **Rs 25.65 cr** from 297 donations followed by **AAP**, which has declared receiving **Rs 24.73 cr** from 3865 donations. **SAD** declared receiving **Rs 15.45 cr** that is the third highest amongst all regional parties.
- d. **72.05%** or **Rs 65.83 cr** of the total donations received by Regional Parties have been received solely by top three Regional Parties.



## II. Comparison of donations received by Regional Parties between FY 2015-16 and FY 2016-17


- AGP, SAD, JDS, MNS and AAP** saw the maximum percentage increase in their income from donations between FY 2015-16 and 2016-17.
- Donations to **AGP** increased by **7183%**, followed by **SAD** for which it was **5842%**, and **JDS** that saw an increase of **596%**.
- Amongst the top five parties, only **Shiv Sena** saw a decline in the donations received from FY 2015-16. The donations that it had received in FY 2015-16, declined by **70%** or **Rs 61.19 cr** in FY 2016-17.



## III. Cash donations declared by the Regional Parties – FY 2016-17


ECI [notification dated 29<sup>th</sup> August, '14](#) stated that “...no tax deduction shall be allowed on the contributions made in cash by any person or company to a political party”. This notification was applicable for donations made from FY 2014-15 onwards. But, the Regional Parties have declared receiving Rs 2.82 cr via donations in cash.


- Out of the total donations of **Rs 91.37 cr** declared by the Regional Parties, **Rs 2.82 cr** from **1919 donations** was received in cash during FY 2016-17. This formed **3.09%** of the **total donations** to the parties.
- Maximum donations in cash** was declared by **AINRC**, which collected a total of **Rs 65 lakhs**, followed by **AGP** with **Rs 41.2 lakhs** and **NPF** with **Rs 41 lakhs**.
- Among all the states, donors from **Assam** made the highest donations of **Rs 72.7 lakhs** in cash followed by donors from **Puducherry** who donated a total of **Rs 65.3 lakhs** in cash.
- Donations worth Rs 60 lakhs in cash did not have address details. 6 Regional Parties (NPF, MGP, DMK, BPF, Shiv Sena and AGP)** have received such donations in FY 2016-17. (Refer: Annexure 1)



#### IV. State-wise donations to Regional Parties


- Segregation of donations according to location** was made by ADR based on the **addresses** provided by the parties in their donations report to the ECI.
- Donations declared by the Regional Parties contained details of donations received from 29 States/Union Territories/common capitals and 27 countries according to the declared address of donors. Only AAP declared donations from abroad.
- Regional parties have declared receiving the highest amount of money or **Rs 20.86 cr** from **Delhi**, followed by **Rs 19.7 cr** from **Maharashtra** and **Rs 9.42 cr** from **Punjab**.
- 35.67%** or **Rs 8.82 cr** of the total declared donations to **AAP** was received from **abroad**. (Refer: Annexure- 2)
- A total of **Rs 14.38 cr**, (15.74% of total donations received by the Regional parties, FY 2016-17), **could not be attributed to any State/Union Territory due to incomplete or lack of information provided by the parties.**





**V. Disclosure of PAN details in donations**

- a. Out of 25 Regional Parties who had declared receiving donations, **18 parties**, have **declared donations of donors without their PAN details**.
- b. **Rs 23.08 cr** or **25.26%** of the total amount of donations received by Regional Parties **do not have PAN details**.
- c. It is to be noted that parties like **BPF, MGP, PMK, RJD** and **ZNP** who have declared 100 percent donations, **have not provided PAN details of even a single donor** in their donations statement.
- d. It is seen that **AAP** declared receiving **Rs 8.82 cr from abroad** out of which **PAN details are not available** for donations amounting to **Rs 8.32 cr**.



## Recommendations

- a. The Supreme Court gave a judgment on September 13, 2013 declaring that no part of a candidate's affidavit should be left blank. Similarly, **no part of the Form 24A submitted by political parties providing details of donations above Rs 20,000 should be blank.**
- b. The National and Regional Parties should, ideally, **lead by example** by filing **complete and correct statements** of donations to the ECI **well in time** for public scrutiny so as to encourage financial transparency.
- c. Parties **not adhering** to the deadline fixed by the Election Commission of India should be **penalized** by making them **liable to pay tax on 100% of their income** from various sources.
- d. **The National and Regional political parties must provide all information on their finances under the Right to Information Act.** This will go a long way in strengthening political parties, elections and democracy.

## Detailed Report

Political parties rely heavily on donations for contesting elections and running their daily affairs. They receive huge sums of money in the form of donations/ contributions from corporates or business houses, trusts and individuals. Section 29C of the Representation of People Act, 1951 mandates that political parties submit their contribution details in excess of Rs 20,000 received from any person or a company to the ECI annually, in order to enjoy 100% tax exemption.

This report, prepared by **Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR)** focuses on donations received by 48 Regional Political Parties, during the Financial Year 2016-17, as submitted by the parties to the Election Commission of India (ECI).

### I. Status of submission of contributions report by Regional Parties to ECI (FY 2016-17)

Out of 48 regional parties analyzed, **only 8** had submitted their donations report to the ECI in the stipulated time period. 24 other regional parties have delayed their submission by a maximum of 249 days (or 8.3 months) to 2 days. There are **16 regional parties who have defaulted** in the submission of their donations report to the ECI during FY 2016-17, till date, 6<sup>th</sup> August, 2018.



## II. Donations declared by Regional Parties to the ECI (FY 2016-17)

- Under **Section 29C(1) of the Representation of People's Act, 1951**, political parties are required to prepare a report providing details of contributions **in excess of twenty thousand rupees** from any person in a particular financial year to avail 100% tax exemption.
- However, in FY 2016-17, we see that **7 Regional Parties** (SAD, MGP, DMK, AINRC, AGP, NPF and DMDK) have also provided details of donations received **below Rs 20,000** in their contributions report, amounting to **Rs 1.29 cr.**
- The total amount of donations declared by Regional Parties, including both above and below Rs 20,000, was **Rs 91.37 cr**, from **6339 donations**.
- With regard to the total amount of donations, **Shiv Sena** leads with **Rs 25.65 cr** from 297 donations followed by **AAP**, which has declared receiving **Rs 24.73 cr** from 3865 donations. **SAD** declared receiving **Rs 15.45 cr** that is the third highest amongst all regional parties.
- 72.05%** or **Rs 65.83 cr** of the total donations received by regional parties have been received solely by top three regional parties.
- No donations have been declared by **AIADMK, AIFB, BJD, JMM, JKNC** and **JVM-P** for FY 2016-17.




### III. Comparison of donations received by Regional Parties between FY 2015-16 and FY 2016-17

- The overall donations of **11 Regional Parties** saw a **decline** in the current financial year, 2016-17 from the previous financial year, 2015-16.
- 8 regional parties** considered for this report did not submit their contributions report for the past financial year.
- AAP, SAD, JDS, MNS, RLD, SDF, AGP** and **NPF** are the **eight regional parties**, which have declared an **increase** in the amount of donations received between FY 2015-16 and 2016-17.
- Shiv Sena** received the highest amount of donations in both financial years, **2015-16** and **2016-17**.




#### IV. Cash donations declared by Regional Parties in FY 2016-17

- Out of the total donations of **Rs 91.37 cr** declared by the Regional Parties, **Rs 2.82 cr** from **1919 donations** was received in **cash** during FY 2016-17. This formed **3.09%** of the **total donations** to the parties.

- b. **Maximum donations in cash** was declared by **AINRC**, which collected a total of **Rs 65 lakhs**, followed by **AGP** with **Rs 41.2 lakhs** and **NPF** with **Rs 41 lakhs**.
- c. Among all the states, donors from **Assam** made the highest donations of **Rs 72.7 lakhs** in cash followed by donors from **Puducherry** who donated a total of **Rs 65.3 lakhs** in cash.
- d. **6 regional parties (NPF, MGP, DMK, BPF, Shiv Sena and AGP)** have received cash donations worth a total of **Rs 60 lakhs that does not have address details**.
- e. The only donation in cash from outside India is from **UAE**, which was given to **AAP**. Shri Babychan Joseph from Dubai donated Re.1 in cash, Rs 25,000 via cheque and Rs 5,000 through an online transfer.
- f. Amongst all regional parties, **AAP** is only one that has received **some amount of cash donations across 17 states in India**.




## V. State-wise donations to Regional Parties in FY 2016-17


- a. **Segregation of donations according to State and sectors** was made by **ADR** based on the **names and address** provided by the parties in their donations report to the ECI.
- b. Donations declared by the Regional Parties contained details of donations received from **29 States/Union Territories/common capitals** and **27 countries** according to the declared address of donors. Only AAP declared donations from abroad.
- c. Amongst all the states/UTs/common capitals, the highest amount of **Rs 20.86 cr** was donated to the Regional Parties from **Delhi**, followed by **Rs 19.7 cr** from **Maharashtra** and **Rs 9.42 cr** from **Punjab**.
- d. **AAP** has received **Rs 8.82 cr** worth of donations from outside India, becoming the **only regional party** that has **received donations from across 27 countries outside India** (Refer Annexure – 2 for complete details of top 50 donations from abroad).
- e. Top 5 countries from where **AAP** has received donations are **Canada, USA, UAE, Australia** and **UK**.

### Top 5 countries from where AAP received donations in FY 2016-17




### Donations classified based on address as declared by Regional Parties: FY 2016-17



## VI. Mode of contribution to Regional Parties in FY 2016-17

- Regional Parties declared receiving a total of **Rs 54.52 cr** through **cheque/DD** from a total of **570 donations**, forming **59.67%** of the total donations received. While **2942 donations**, amounting to **Rs 17.78 cr** was received in the form of **bank transfer**, forming **19.46%** of the total donations received.
- Rs 16.25 cr** or **17.78%** of the total amount of donations received was from donations with incomplete or undeclared mode of payment details.
- 1919 donations** amounting to **Rs 2.82 cr** was received in cash.

## VII. Disclosure of PAN details of donors by Regional parties, FY 2016-17

- Out of 25 Regional Parties who had declared receiving donations, **18 parties**, have **declared receiving 4131 donations without PAN details**.
- Parties like **BPF, MGP, PMK, RJD** and **ZNP** who have declared 100 percent donations, **have not provided PAN details of even a single donor** in its donations statement.
- AAP** has received the maximum amount, **Rs 13.92 cr** from donations without PAN details, followed by **MGP**, which received an amount of **Rs 3.64 cr**, and **SAD** that received **Rs 1.55 cr** from such similar donations.
- It is to be noted that **AAP** declared receiving **Rs 8.82 cr from abroad** out of which **PAN details are not available** for donations amounting to **Rs 8.32 cr**.
