# **Analysis of Sessions and Number of Sittings in the 17th Bihar Assembly**

- The 17th Bihar Assembly held 15 sessions between November 2020 and July 2025, with a total of 146 sittings during this period.
- Over these five years, the Bihar Assembly sat for an average of 29 days per year.
- The longest sessions were the 2nd and 5th sessions, each having 22 sittings.




Figure: Sessions and Sittings of the Assembly




Figure: Party Wise Average Number of Questions Asked

• Highest number of Questions were related to **Rural Works**, **Education** and **Health**.




Figure: Top 10 - Category Wise Questions Asked
