Chandigarh Election Watch Lok Sabha elections 2009

Lok Sabha 2009 elections in Chandigarh were held on May 13th 2009 for one parliamentary constituency. This chapter includes analysis of voting trend, criminalization and money power in these elections.

Political Parties and Candidates

In Lok Sabha 2004, 7 parties contested. This went down to 6 parties in Lok Sabha 2009 elections. In Lok Sabha 2004 elections 17 candidates contested. This went down to 14 candidates in Lok Sabha 2009 elections.

Executive summary

- Affidavits of all 14 candidates contesting the Lok Sabha 2009 elections were analyzed by the Chandigarh Election Watch.
- None of these 14 candidates had pending criminal cases.
- Average asset for a candidate from Chandigarh was 3.7 crores.
- The constituency was won by Pawan Kumar Bansal of INC.
- Average assets for the winner, runner up and second runner up were 9.3 crores.
- There was 1 female candidate from Chandigarh. This candidate did not win.

The % of votes polled by major parties


INC managed to get 47% of the votes cast. This was 31% of the electorate. The total electorate in Chandigarh was 5,24,444 and the total votes cast were 3,43,557.
