Chhattisgarh Election Watch and Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of all 90 newly elected MLAs in the Chhattisgarh 2018 Assembly Elections.

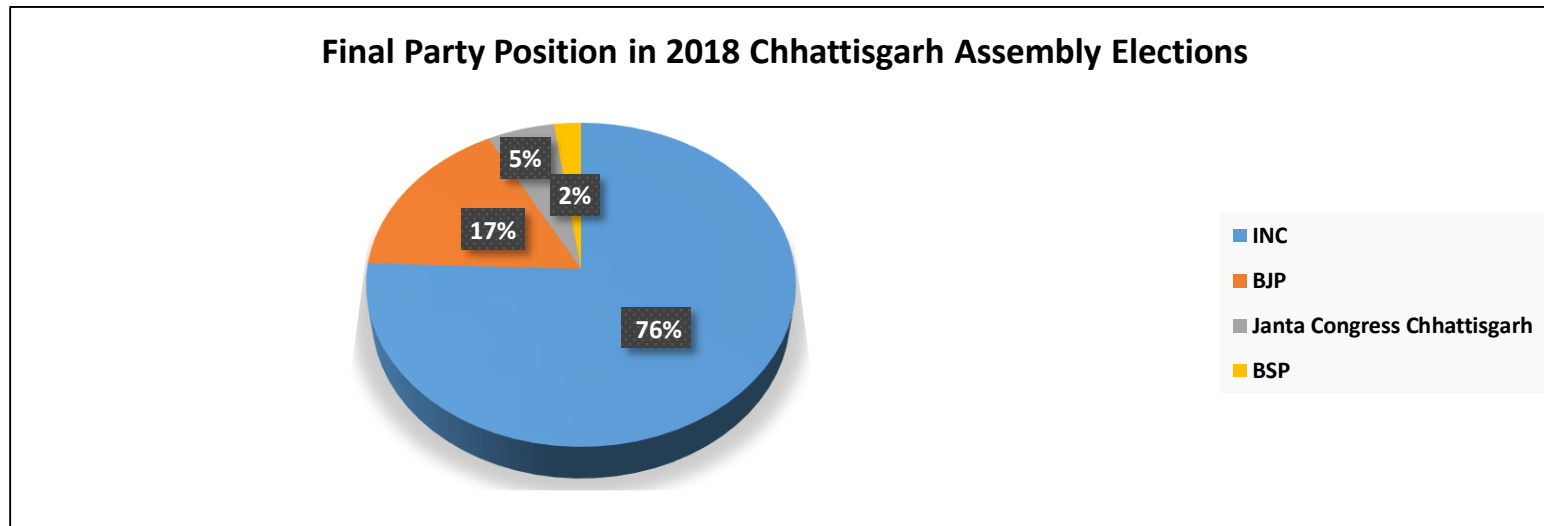


Figure: Final Party Position

CRIMINAL BACKGROUND

- **MLAs with criminal cases:** Out of the **90** MLAs analysed, **24(27%)** MLAs have declared criminal cases against themselves. Out of 90 MLAs analysed during **Chhattisgarh Assembly elections in 2013**, **15(17%)** MLAs had **declared criminal cases** against themselves.
- **MLAs with serious criminal cases:** **13(14%)** MLAs have declared serious criminal cases. Out of **90** MLAs analysed during **Chhattisgarh Assembly elections in 2013**, **8 (9%)** MLAs had **declared serious criminal cases** against themselves.

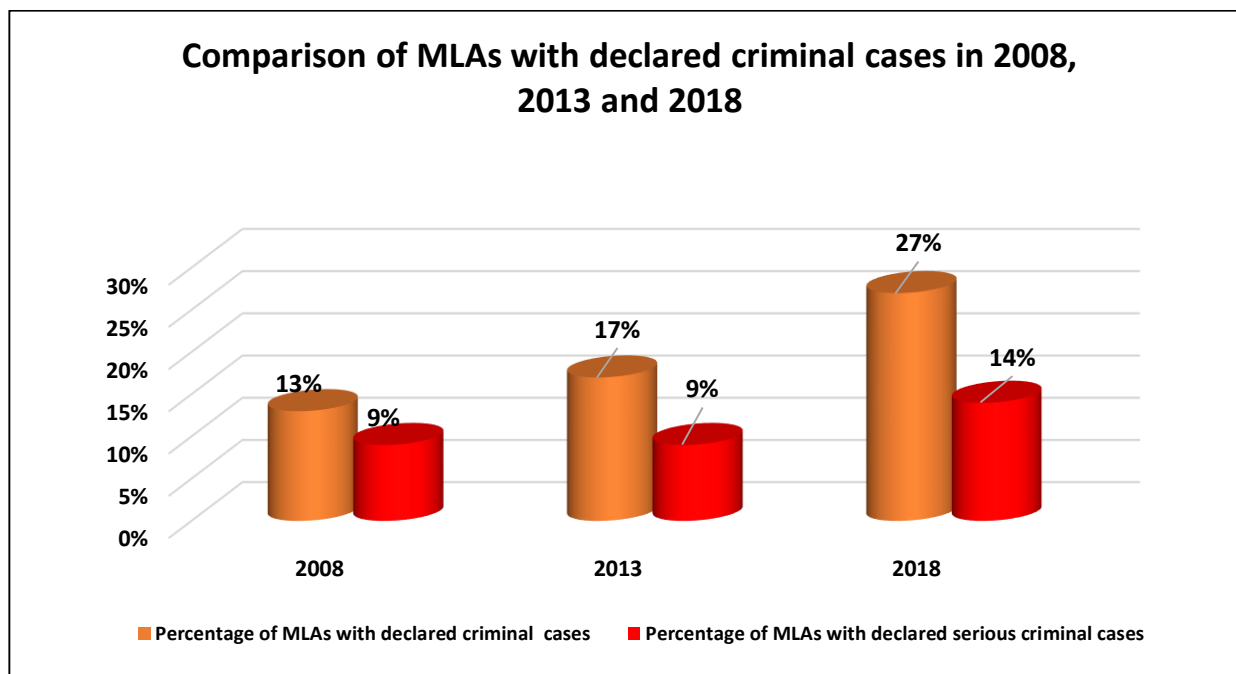
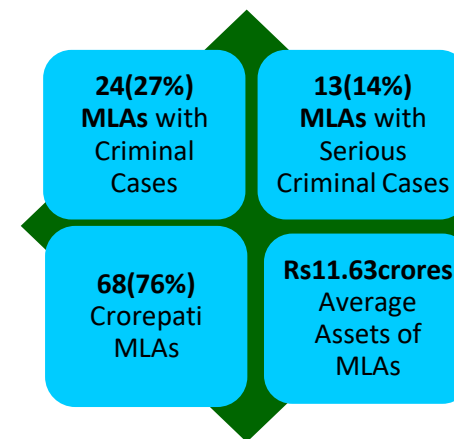


Figure: Comparison of MLAs with declared criminal cases in 2008, 2013 and 2018

Criteria for serious criminal cases

1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
2. If an offence is non-bailable
3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
8. Crimes against women.

- **MLAs with declared cases related to attempt to murder:** 1 MLA has declared cases related to attempt to murder (IPC Section 307).
- **Party wise MLAs with criminal cases:**19(28%) out of 68 MLAs from INC, 3 (20%) out of 15 MLAs from BJP and 2 (40%) out of 5 MLAs from Janta Congress Chhattisgarh(J) MLAs have declared criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.
- **Party wise MLAs with serious criminal cases:** 12(18%) out of 68 MLAs from INC and 1 (20%) out of 5 MLAs from Janta Congress Chhattisgarh(J) MLAs have declared serious criminal cases against themselves in their affidavits.

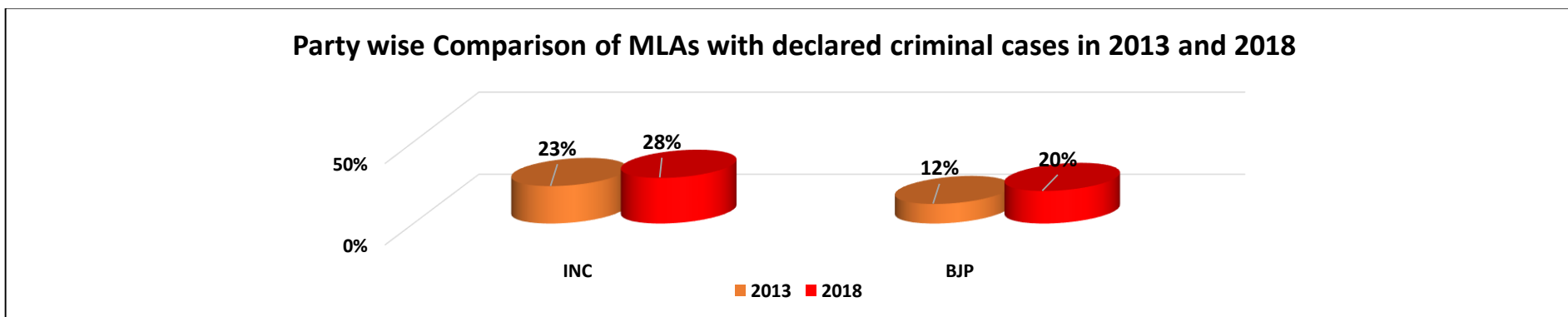


Figure: Party wise comparison of percentage of MLAs with declared criminal cases – 2013 and 2018

FINANCIAL BACKGROUND

- **Crorepati MLAs:** Out of the **90** newly elected MLAs, **68 (76%)** are crorepatis. Out of **90** MLAs analysed during Chhattisgarh 2013 assembly elections, **67(74%)** MLAs were crorepatis.

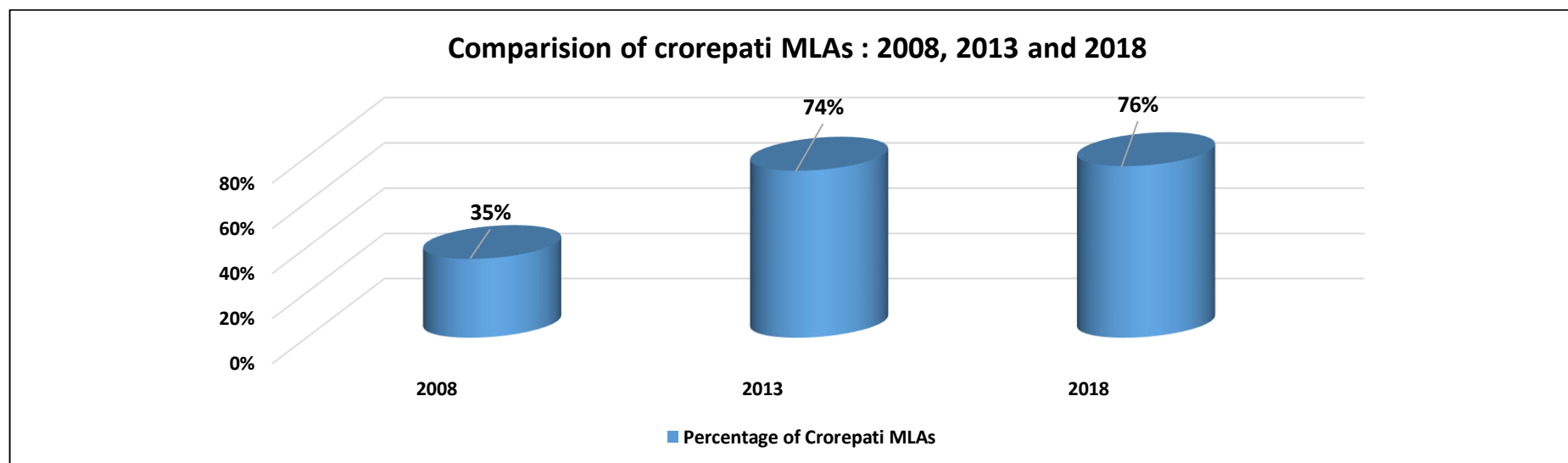


Figure: Comparison of crorepati MLAs: 2008, 2013 and 2018

- **Partywise crorepati MLAs: 48 (71%)** out of 68 MLAs from **INC**, **14 (93%)** out of 15 MLAs from **BJP**, **5(100%)** out of 5 MLAs from **Janta Congress Chhattisgarh(J)** and **1(50%)** out of 2 MLAs from **BSP** have declared assets valued more than Rs 1 crore.

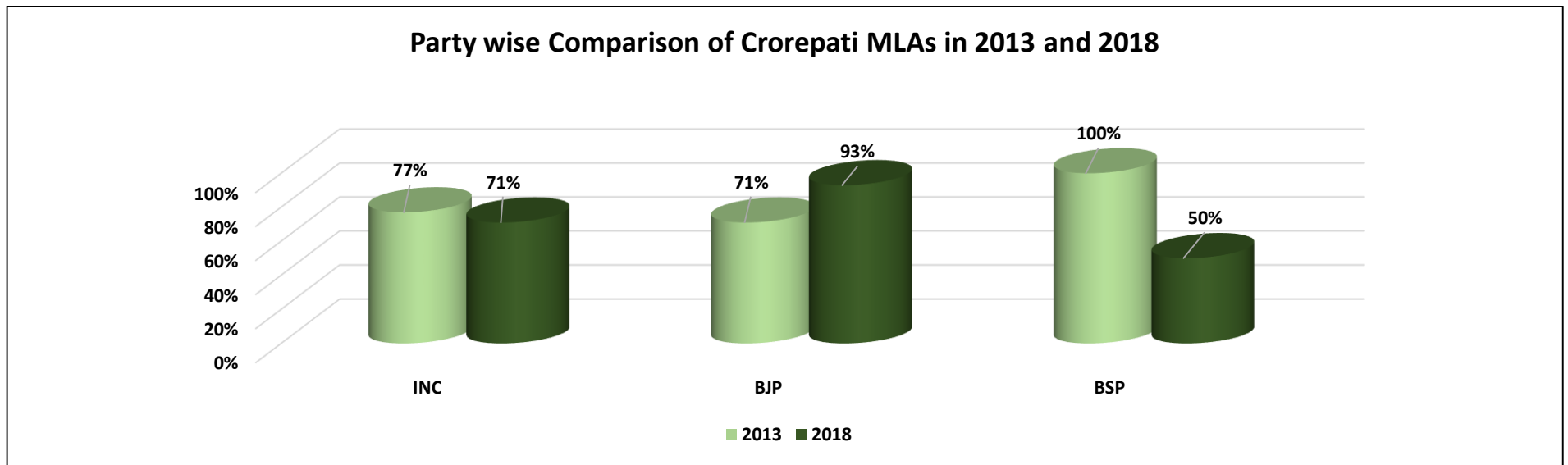


Figure: Party wise Comparison of Crorepati MLAs in 2013 and 2018

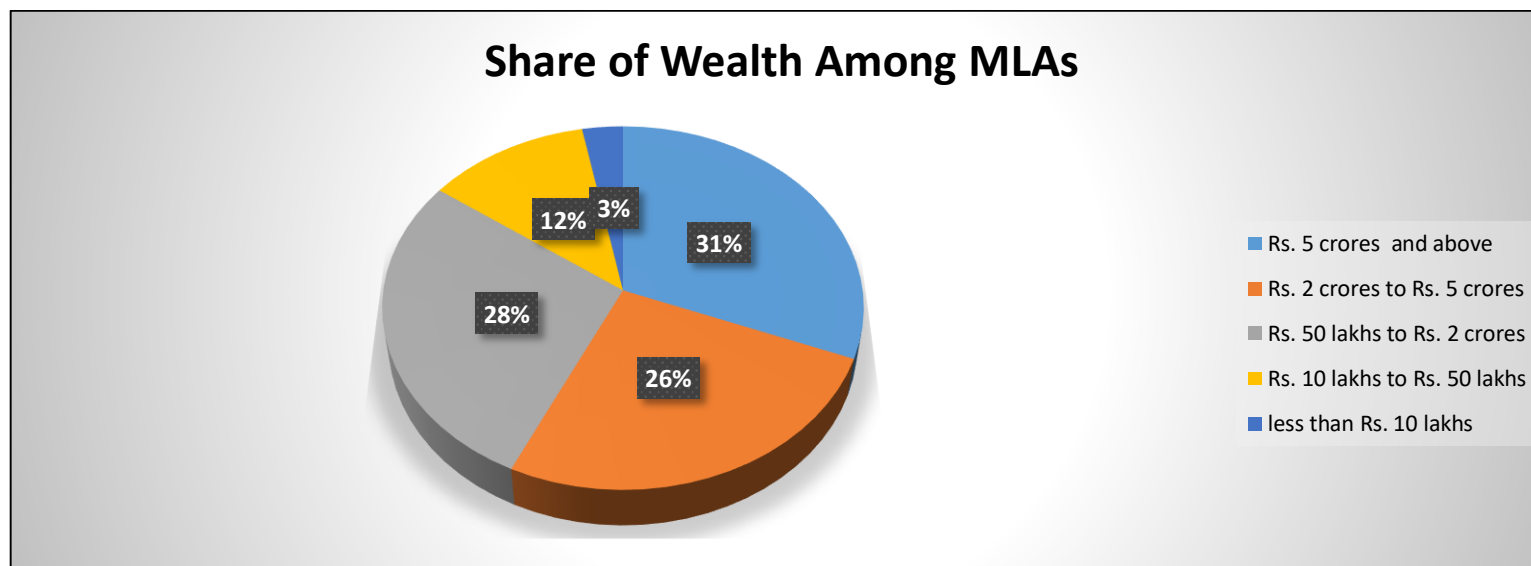


Figure: Share of Wealth Among MLAs

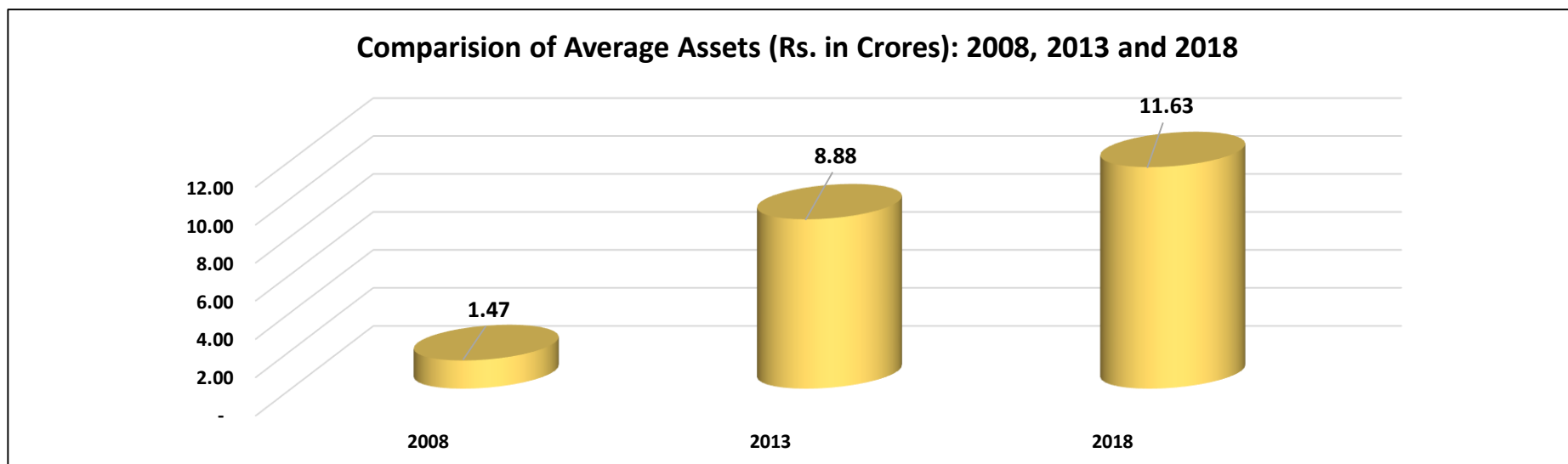


Figure: Comparison of Average Assets (Rs. in Crores): 2008, 2013 and 2018

- **MLAs who have not declared Income Tax Details*:** 11 (12%) MLAs out of 90 analyzed have not declared income tax details.

** Some MLAs may be exempted from filing Income Tax Return*

OTHER BACKGROUND DETAILS

- **Education Details of MLAs:** 27 (30%) MLAs have declared their educational qualification to be between 5th pass and 12th pass while 32 (69%) MLAs have declared having an educational qualification of **graduate or above**. There is 1 MLA who has declared himself as just **literate**.
- **Age details of MLAs:** 16 (18%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 25 and 40 years while 54 (60%) MLAs have declared their age to be between 41 and 60 years. There are 20(22%) MLAs who have declared their age to be between 61 to 80 years.

Gender details of MLAs: Out of 90 MLAs, 13 (14%) MLAs are women. In 2013, out of 90 MLAs, 10(11%) MLAs were women

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF ASSETS OF RE-ELECTED MLAS

- **Number of re-elected MLAs:** Number of re-elected MLAs analysed in the assembly elections of 2018 is 30.
- **Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2013:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2013 was **Rs 21.50 crores**
- **Average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2018:** The average assets of re-elected MLAs in 2018 is **Rs 22.03 crores**.
- **Average growth in assets of re-elected MLAs from 2013 to 2018:** The growth in average assets of re-elected MLAs is **Rs 52.63 lacs i.e. by 2%**.

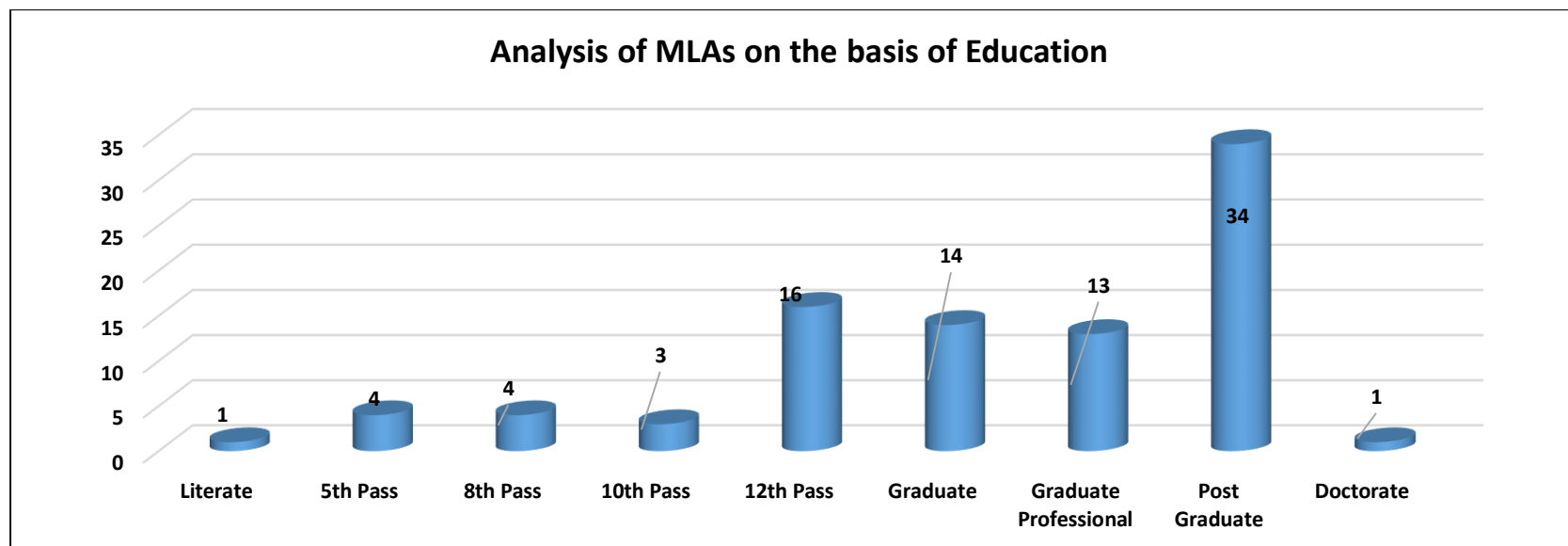


Figure: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of education

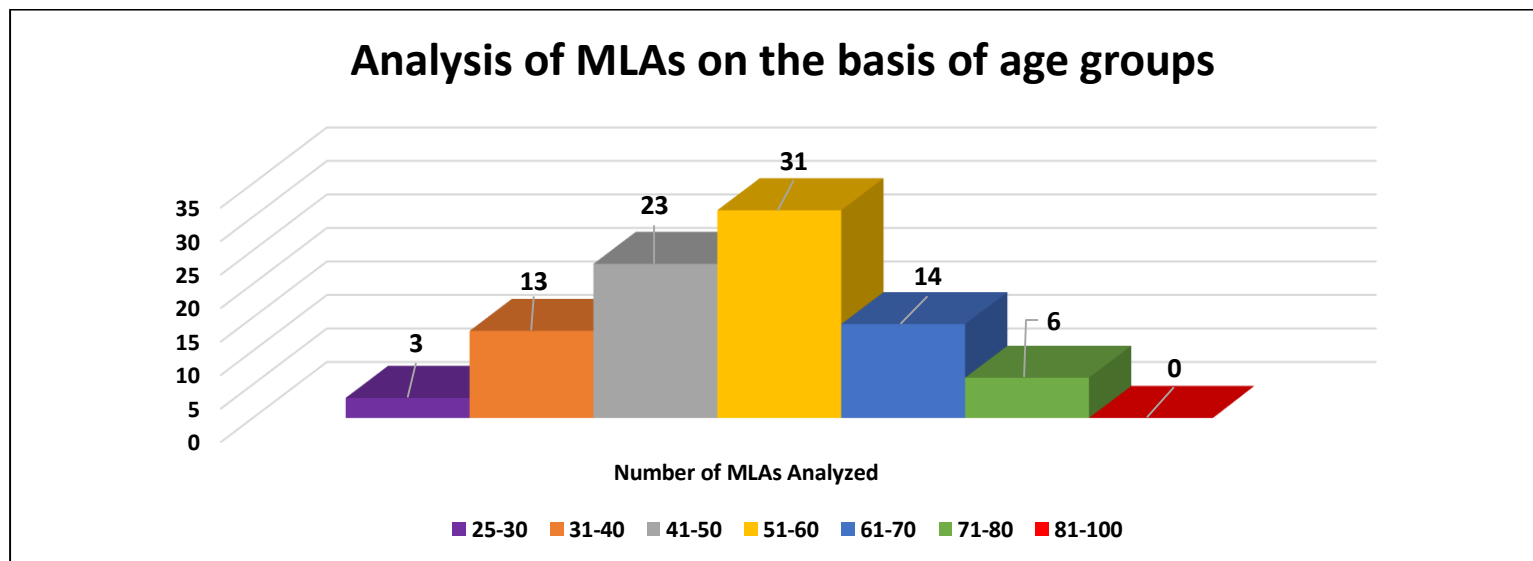


Figure: Analysis of MLAs on the basis of age groups

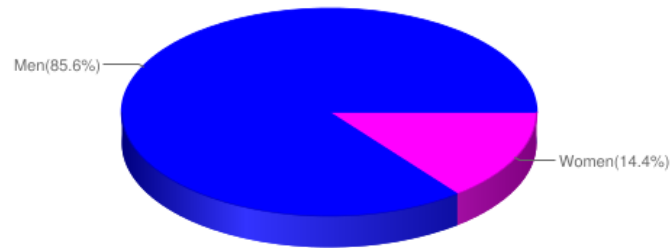
