Analysis of the MLAs from Jharkhand

The following report consists of the financial and criminal details of the Members of legislative Assemblies (MLAs) from Haryana and an overall comparative analysis. As mentioned before, the state has 81 seats of Legislative Assembly and it is represented by 14 seats in Lok Sabha and 6 in Rajya Sabha. The following table gives a summary of the details of all the MLAs:

- Affidavits available for MPs - 72
- MPs with criminal charges - 31 (43.06 %)
- MPs with serious criminal charges - 18 (25.00 %)
- Total criminal cases against MPs - 93
- Total serious IPC sections against MPs - 43
- Total crorepati MPs - 2
