

- <u>Ministers' Education</u>: 8(73%) ministers have declared their educational qualification to be between 10th- 12th pass while 3 (27%) ministers have declared having an educational qualification of graduate or above.
- <u>Ministers' Age:</u> A total of **4(36%)** ministers have declared their age to be between **25-50 years** while **7(64%)** ministers have declared their age to be between **51-80** years.
- Women Ministers: Out of 11 ministers, only 1 is woman.
