Executive Summary - Phase 1

Criminal Background

- <u>Candidates with Criminal Cases</u>: Out of the 8 candidates analysed, 2 candidates (25%) have declared criminal cases against himself.
- <u>Candidates with Serious Criminal Cases:</u> Out of 8 candidates, 1 candidate, Soni Soree of Aam Aadmi Party from Bastar constituency has declared a serious criminal case relating to causing mischief by fire or explosive substance

Financial Background

- <u>Crorepati Candidates:</u> Out of the 8 candidates analysed, 3
 (38%) are crorepatis.
- Average Assets: The average assets per candidate contesting in the 3rd phase of 2014 Lok Sabha Elections from Chhattisgarh is Rs.1.03 crores.

Criteria for serious criminal cases

- 1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- 2. If an offence is non-bailable
- If it is an electoral offence (IPC 171E or bribery)
- 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
- 5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- 8. Crimes against women.
- <u>High Asset Candidates</u>: 3 candidates have more than Rs. 1 crore worth of assets. Total Assets includes assets of self, spouse and dependents. The top three candidates with highest assets are given below:

 <u>Candidates who have not give value for Immovable Assets:</u> 1 candidate, Vimla Shoree of CPI from Bastar constituency has not given value for residential buildings that she has declared in her affidavit





- <u>Candidates with Liabilities:</u> A total of 6 candidates out of 8 analyzed have declared liabilities. <u>Dinesh Kashyap</u> of <u>BJP</u> has declared liabilities of <u>Rs. 21.91 lakhs</u> followed by <u>Arjun Singh Thakur</u> of Ambedkarite Party of India and <u>Soni Soree</u> of <u>AAP</u> with liabilities of <u>Rs. 2.50 lakhs</u>.
- <u>Candidates with High Income</u>: Dinesh Kashyap of BJP has declared the highest total income of Rs 12.66 lakhs in his Income Tax Returns followed by Deepak Karma of INC with a total income of Rs 8.78 lakhs and Arjun Singh Thakur of Ambedkarite Party of India with a total income of Rs. 5.68 crores. *Total income includes income of elf, spouse and dependents
- <u>Candidates who have not declared Income Tax Details*:</u> 3 Candidates out of 8 analyzed have not declared income tax details.* Some candidates may be exempted from filing Income Tax Returns
- Undeclared PAN: 2 (25%) out of 8 candidates analysed have not declared their PAN details.


